

Word formation: common prefixes and suffixes

VERB-NOUN

- Word formation involves building up complex words from base morphemes and affixes.
- Examples:

Verb	Agentive Nouns (verb + -er)
(to) teach	teacher
(to) drive	driver
(to) kill	killer
(to) lead	leader
(to) farm	farmer
