- to be going to выражает личное намерение осуществить некое действие.

*I'm going to get the Master's degree.*

- есть факты, основания, доказательства, что действие произойдет (present evidence)

**am  
is + going to  
are**

**Future Simple**

- действие в отдаленном будущем / предположение о будущем / обещания (часто с глаголами think, expect, believe; выражениями be sure, be afraid; наречиями probably, perhaps, certainly, ...)

*Their daughter will probably become a famous teacher.*

- только что принятое решение (указывают на спонтанность / сиюминутность решения)

*The Chemistry teacher is too strict. I will not go to her lessons.*

- действие в будущем, на которое нельзя повлиять

*Our vocabulary test will start in 30 minutes.*
