to fly a kite.

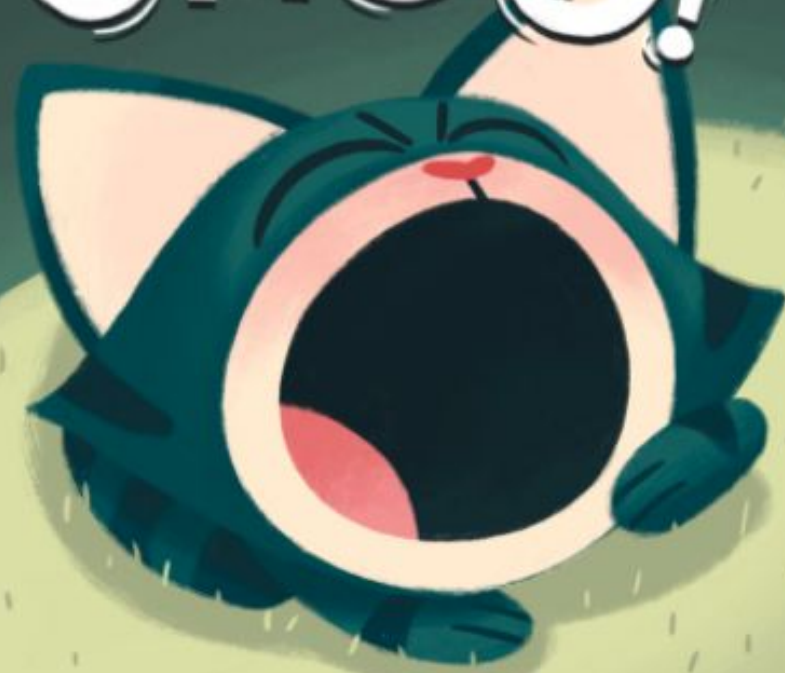


Dragon finds his kite.

It soothes her sore throat.

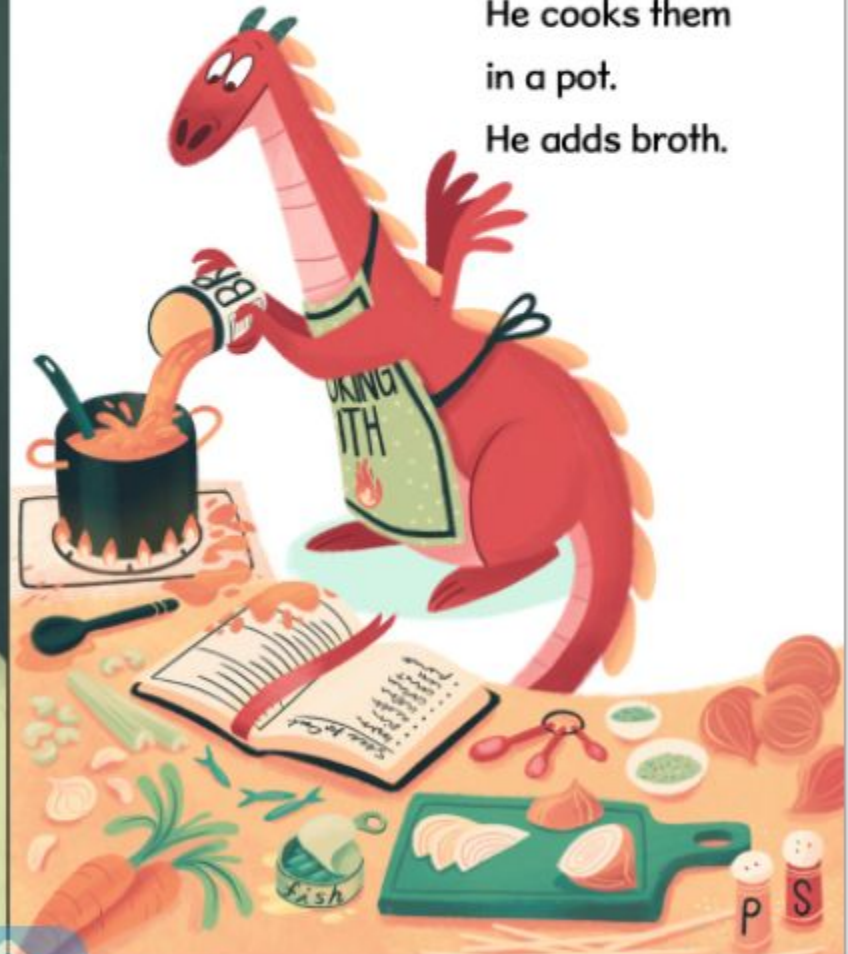


She goes back to sleep.

He starts again.



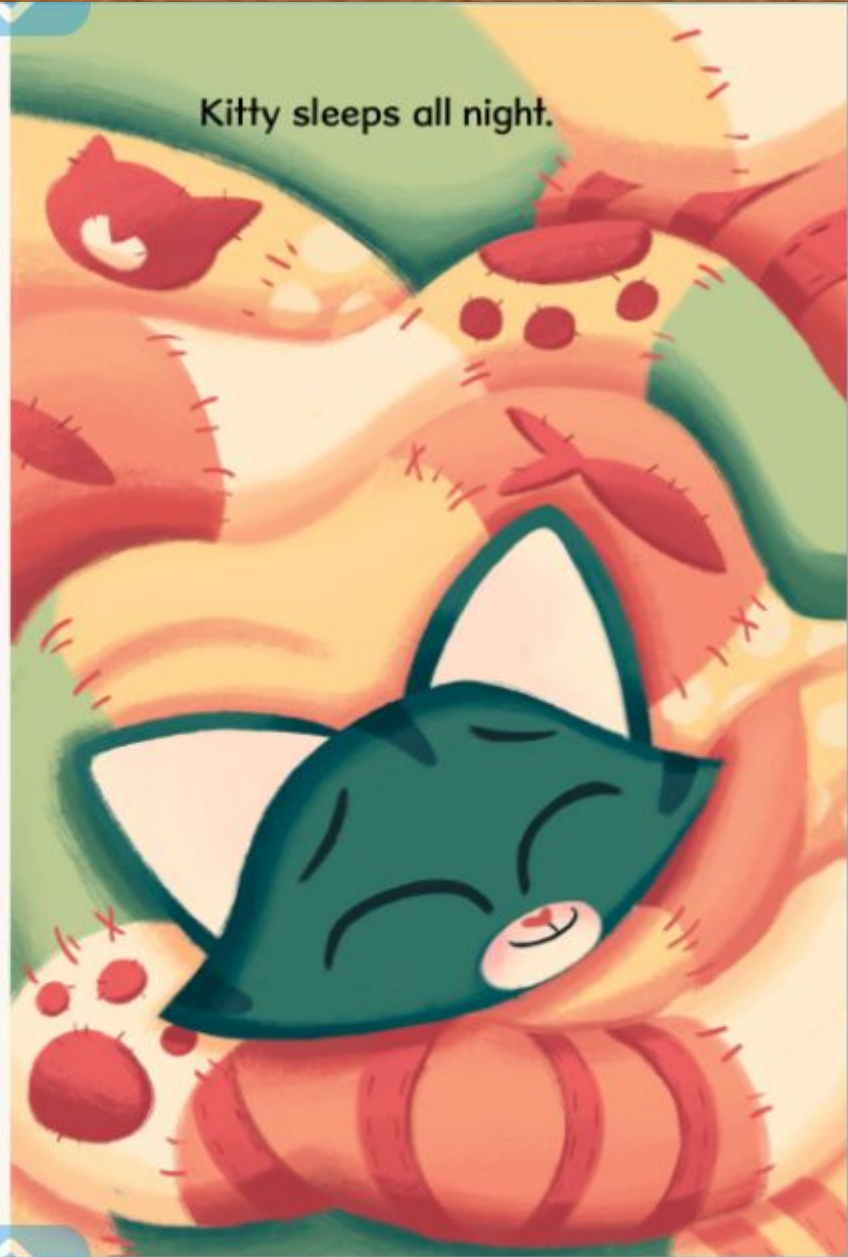
When he is done,
