Steve: Off we go!



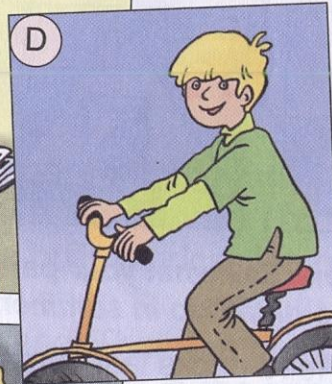

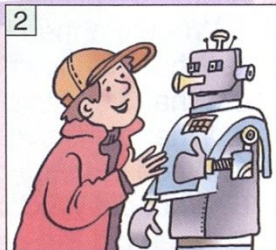
## My best day out.
