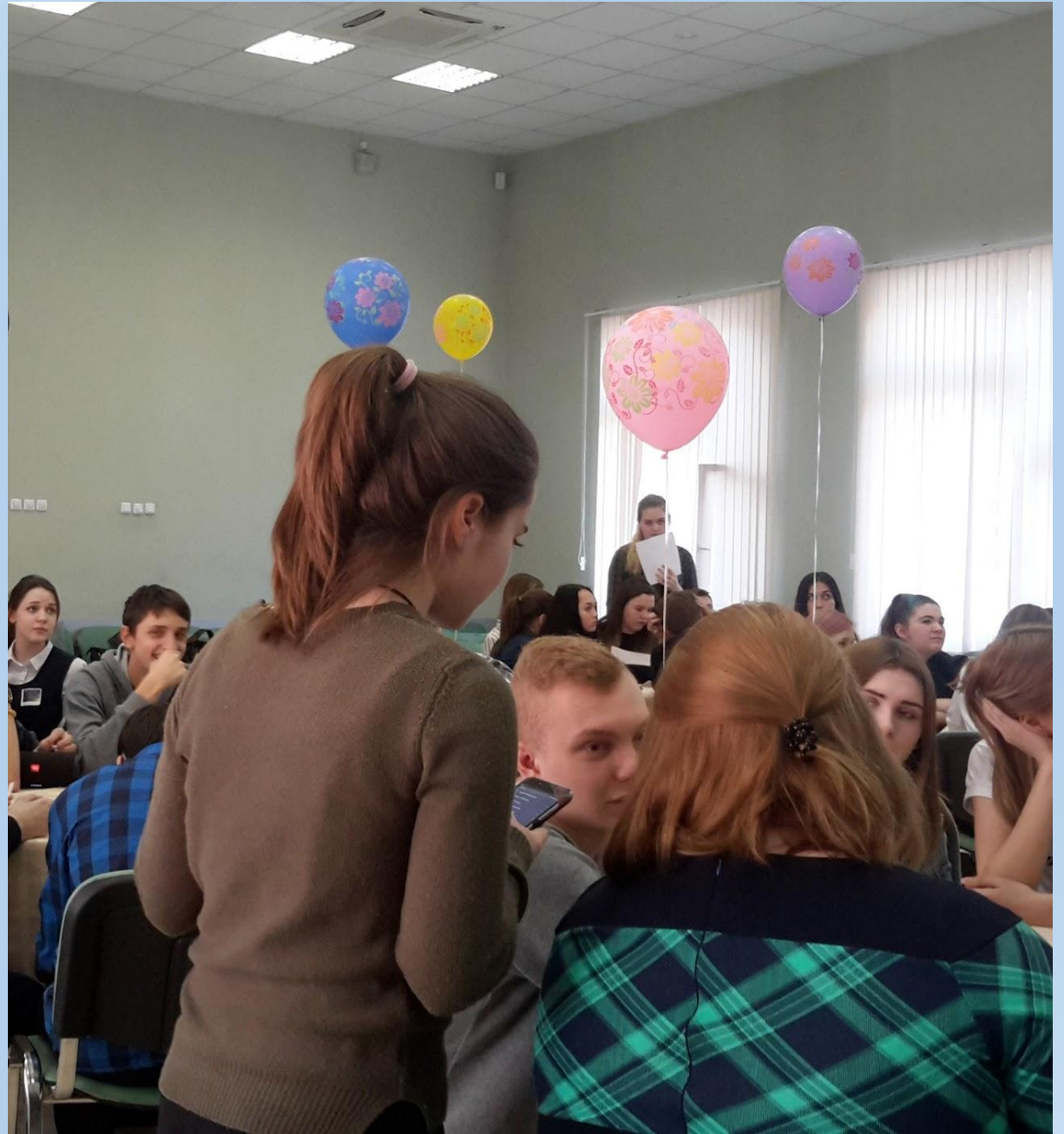
- В рамках "Дней иностранного языка" состоялась Интерактивная командная игра среди студентов 1 курсов трёх отделений Колледжа "Царицыно".
- 7 команд боролись за право стать членами Клуба молодых детективов "Baker Street Club".

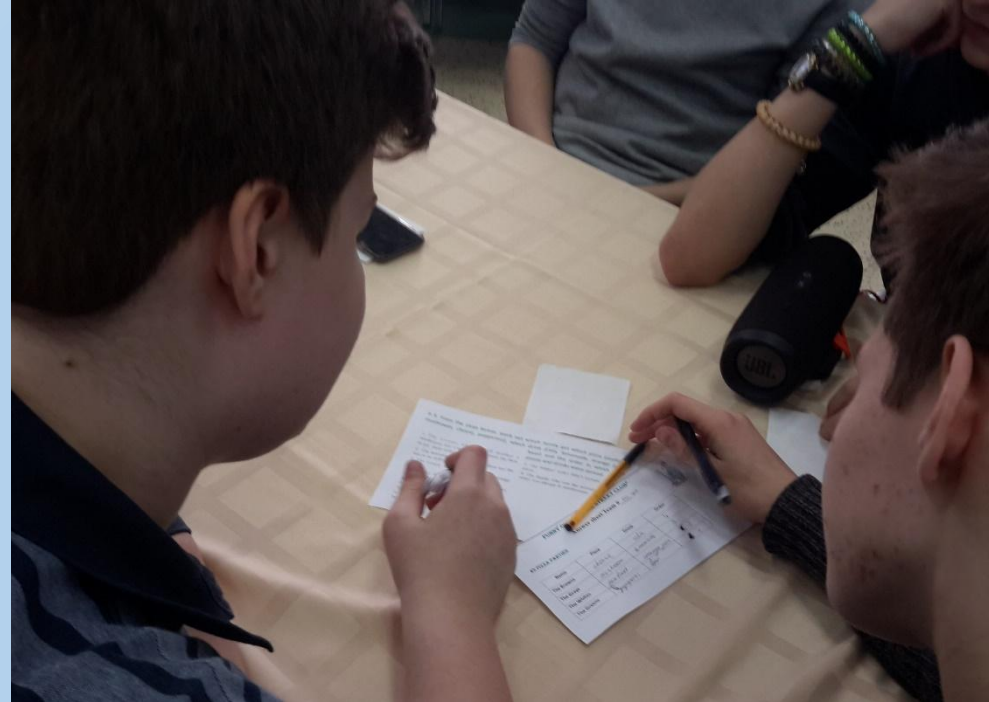




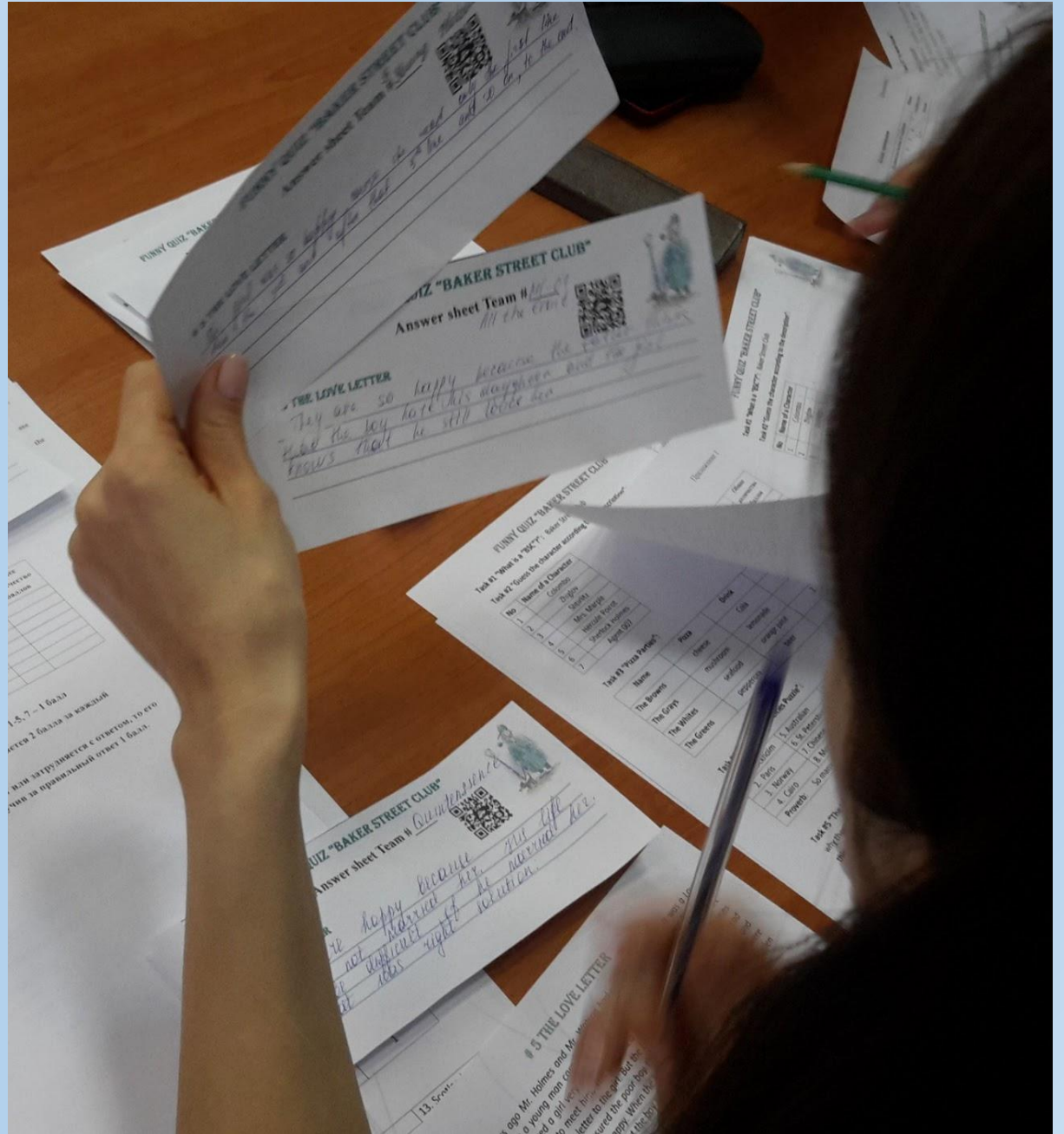
