The test <u>will be written</u> by the students tomorrow.

PRESENT CONTINUOUS продолженное (to be + V ing)

To be (am, is, are) + being + V3

The tests <u>are being written</u> by the students now.

PAST CONTINUOUS

To be (was, were) being+V3

The test <u>was being written</u> by the students for two hours yesterday.

FUTURE CONTINUOUS

To be (will be) + being +V3
The test will be being written by the students from 10 till 11 tomorrow.

PRESENT PERFECT завершенное (have, has + Vз)

have, has + been + V3

The tests <u>have already been written</u> by the students.

PAST PERFECT

had + been + V3

The test <u>had been written</u> by the students by the end of the lesson yesterday.

FUTURE PERFECT

will have + been +V3

The reports <u>will have been written</u> by the students by tomorrow.

В английском языке имеется только один способ выражения страдательного залога, в русском языке существует три способа его передачи:

- а) при помощи <u>глагола</u> быть и краткой формы <u>причастия</u> страдательного залога. (Этот способ аналогичен способу выражения страдательного залога в английском языке
- б) <u>глагола</u>ми, оканчивающимися на *-ся*: дом строится, дом строился, дом будет строиться;
- в) неопределенно-личным оборотом с <u>глаголом</u> в действительном залоге в 3-м лице множественного числа: дом строят, дом строили, дом будут строить.

Иногда английский страдательный оборот можно перевести двумя или даже всеми тремя способами в зависимости от соответствующего русского <u>глагола</u> и контекста:

I was invited to the concert.

The goods were examined yesterday.

PRESENT PERFECT

have, has + been + V3

4. The patient (take) to the hospital today an (operate) tomorrow morning.

4. The patient <u>has been taken</u> to the hospital today and <u>will be operated</u> tomorrow morning.

PRESENT PERFECT FUTURE SIMPLE

have, has + been + V3

To be (will be) + V3

5. This room (use) only on special occasions.

5. This room is used only on special occasions.

PRESENT SIMPLE

To be (is, am, are) +V3

6. We (tell) about it already.

6. We have been told about it already.

PRESENT PERFECT

have, has + been + V3

7. Dictionaries may not (use) at the examination.

7. Dictionaries <u>may</u> not <u>be used</u> at the examination.

8. Usually the experiments (carry out) every day, but they (not carry out) yesterday.

8. Usually the experiments <u>are carried</u> every day, but they <u>were not carried</u> yesterday.

PAST SIMPLE

To be (was, were) +V3

9. The report (tell) by the student from my group to the audience at the moment.

9. The report <u>is being told</u> by the student from my group to the audience at the moment.

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

To be (am, is, are) + being + V3

10. This text (translate) by 9 o'clock tomorrow.

10. This text <u>will have been translated</u> by 9 o'clock tomorrow.

FUTURE PERFECT

will have + been +V3
