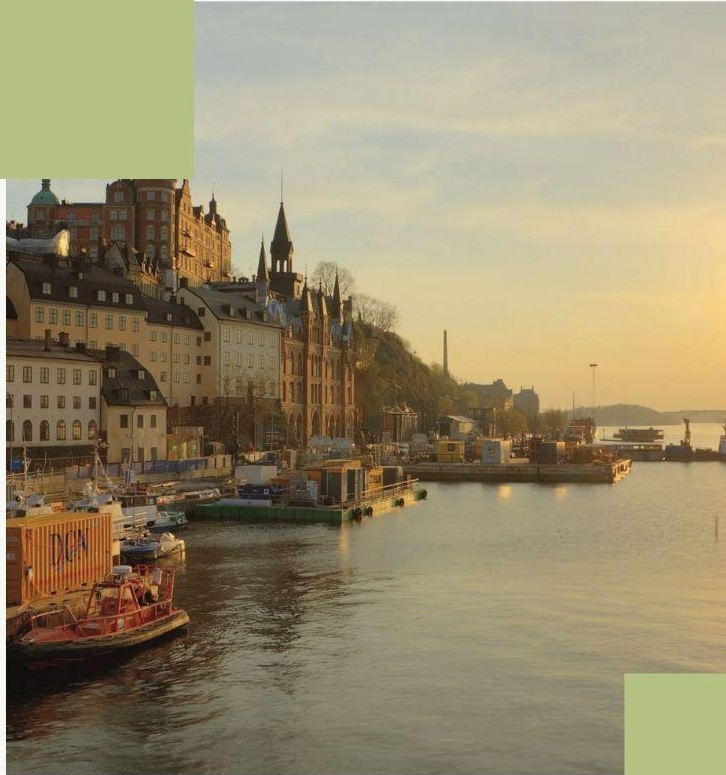

MEDICAL EDUCATION IN SWEDEN

consists of a 5.5-year basic university program that leads to the qualification of “Master of Science in Medicine” (Läkarexamen) and an 18-month internship (Allmäntjänstgöring), providing rotations in surgery (3-6 months), therapy (3-6 months), psychiatry (3 months) and family medicine (6 months).



After a successful internship, a doctor is awarded a medical license (legitimation), which is equivalent to the title of MD in the world. legitimation entitles a doctor to start a specialization in one of the 52 specialties, lasting from 5 years.

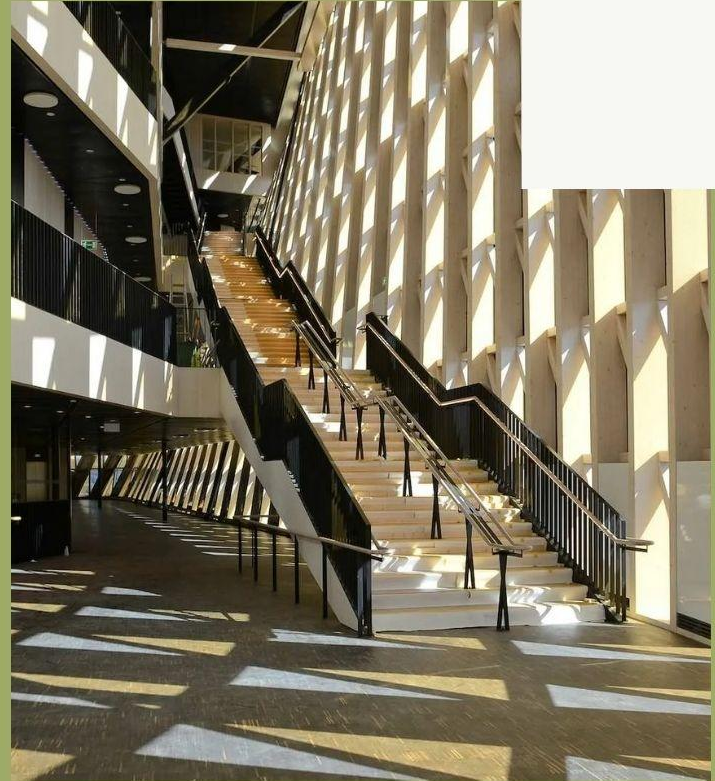

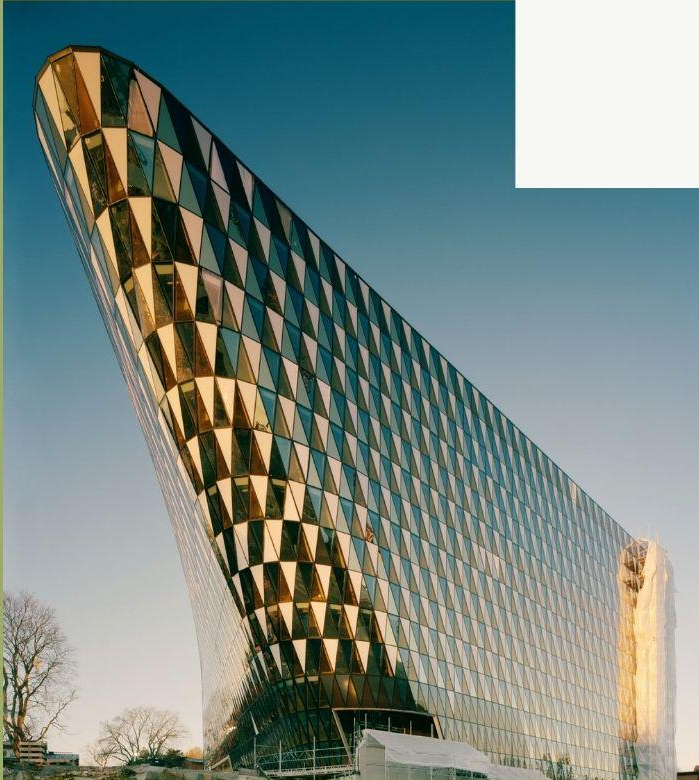
Karolinska Institutet is a single-faculty university specializing exclusively in medical sciences, with a reputation for high-quality research and innovation.

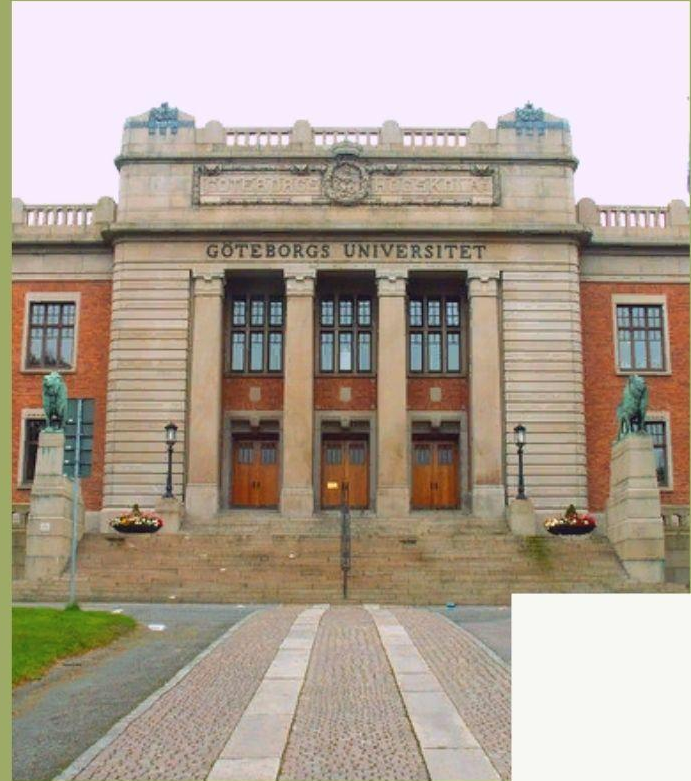
