# INTRODUCTION

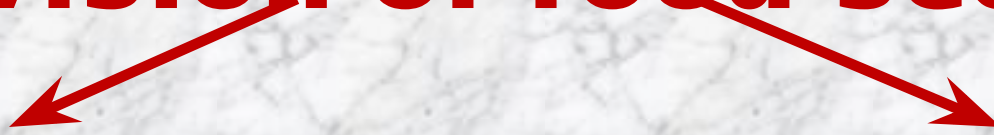
- ❑ Since, the independence of india the national symbols were made at different times in history.

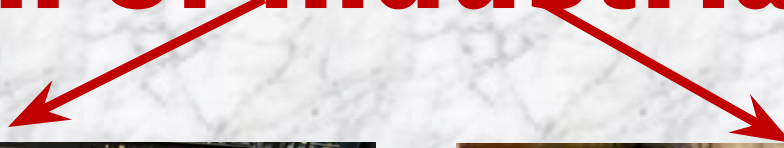
# INDUSTRIAL SECTOR

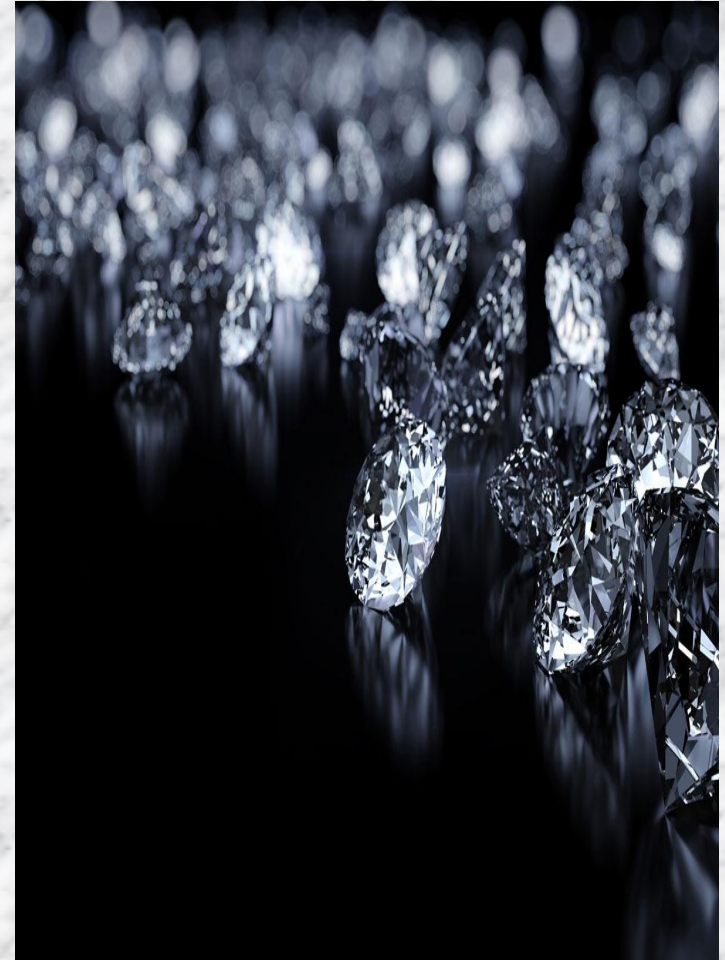
# Textile industry
