



To Play: Give students fly swatters, play slide show. Click to the first letter slide, every 15 seconds the uppercase letter on the screen will change. When students see the letter they use the fly swatter to swat the lowercase letter on their recording sheet.

The Fly Swatters:

I found these super cute mini fly swatters you can make with a tongue depressor and plastic canvas online.





However, after I made this game I couldn't wait to use it with the students until I got some plastic canvas at the craft store, so I settled for a tongue depressor with a square piece of construction paper taped on the top. It worked out perfectly!







To create, print both pages and tape together.
