It is situated on the banks of the River Thames.*



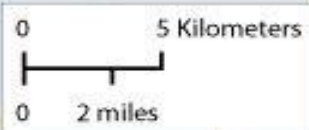
The rebuilding of London followed the medieval plan, but the old wooden houses were replaced by buildings of brick to reduce the fire risk.

as the residence of Prime Minister.*



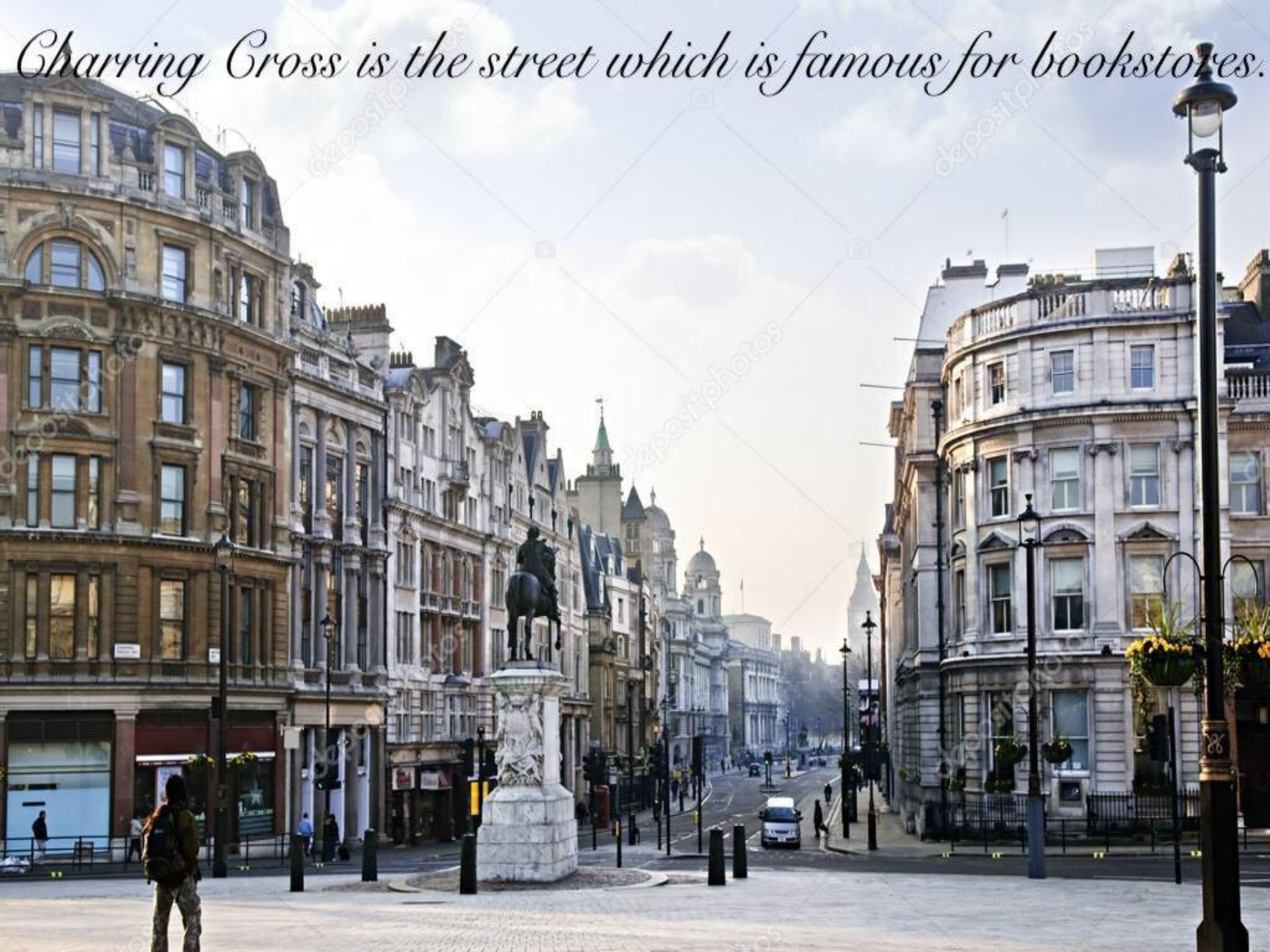
Fleet Street is associated with British newspapers.



Harley Street is the place where the highest paid doctors live.

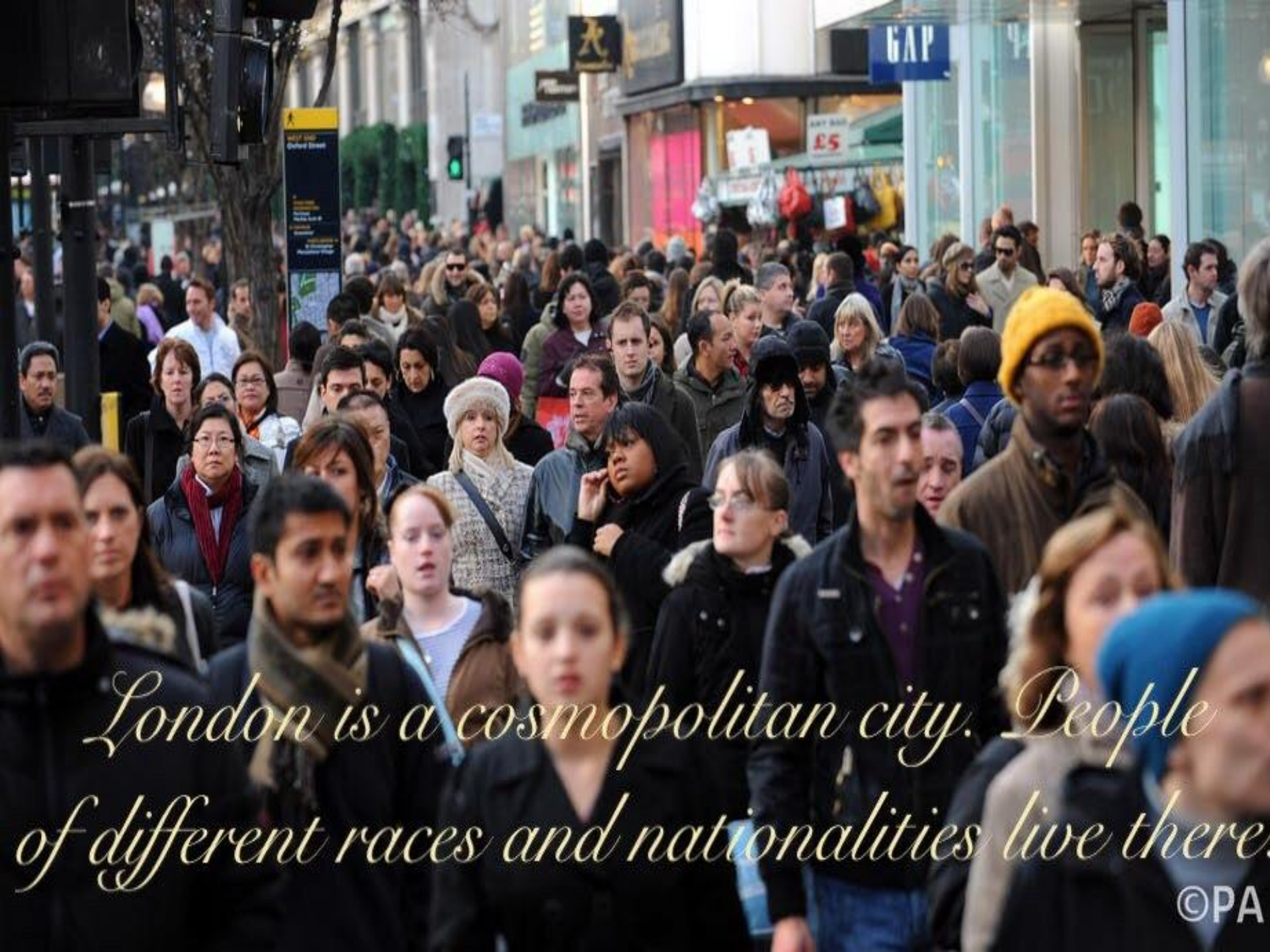


Charring Cross is the street which is famous for bookstores.
