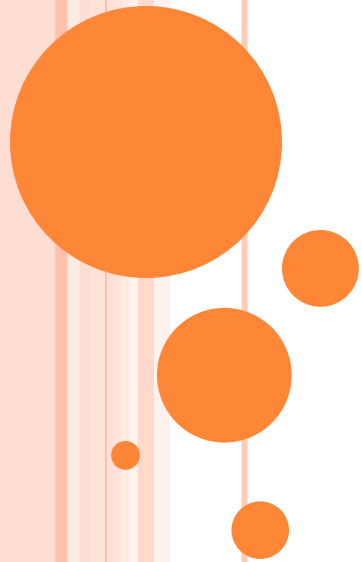

They won`t get married,

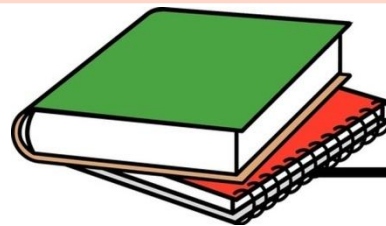
**question**

Will you live more than 78 years?


**short answers**

Yes, I will. / No, I won`t.




