She made her first Hollywood film in 1998. She won an Oscar for 'Best Actress' three years ago for *Vicky Cristina Barcelona*.

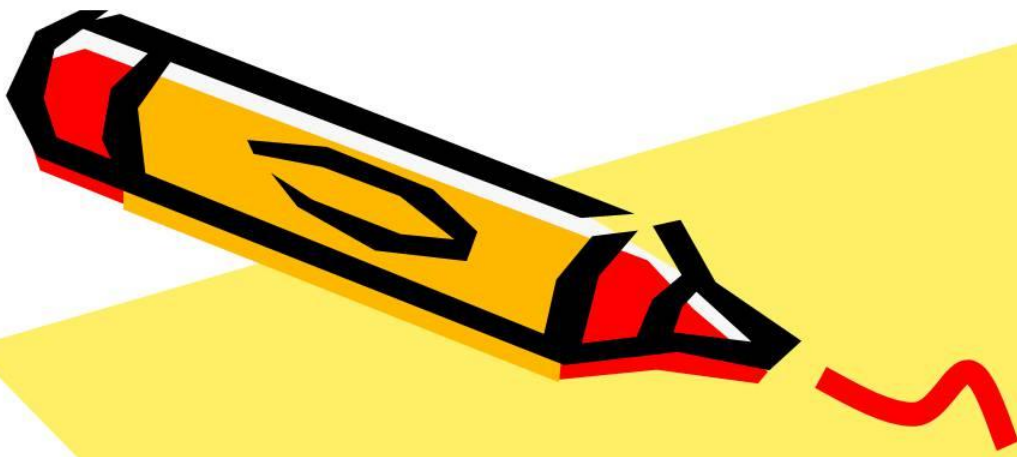

Past Simple



Окончание **-ed** читается как [d], [t], [ɪd] в зависимости от предшествующего звука

a) после звонких согласных (кроме d) и гласных - произносится, как [d]

live-lived-[livd]

b) после глухих согласных (кроме t) - произносится, как [t]

help-helped-[helpt], ask-asked-[askt]

c) после d и t - произносится, как [ɪd]

intend-intended-[ɪn'tendɪd],
want-wanted-['wɒntɪd]

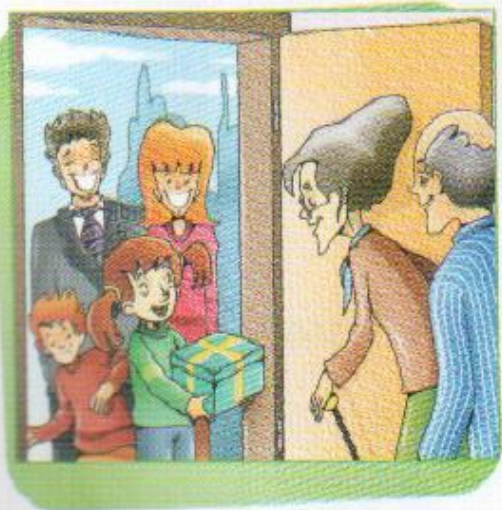
