I am from the city of Novomichurinsk. It is a small town in the Ryazan region, located on the banks of the Pronya River, 85 kilometers from the regional center.



Novomichurinsk got its name in honor of the Russian biologist and breeder I. V. Michurin.

In the spring of 1968, during the construction of the Ryazan State District Power Plant, a workers' settlement was founded. At this time, all social facilities of the village were located in prefabricated wooden houses.

In May 1968, the construction of the first apartment building for the builders of the GRES began.



The total number of residents for 2020 is 16.5 thousand people.

The data on the graph show a steady decline in the population from 19,309 people in 2010 to 16,474 people in 2020.

As of January 2019, Novomichurinsk ranked 744th out of 1117 cities in the Russian Federation in terms of the number of residents.
