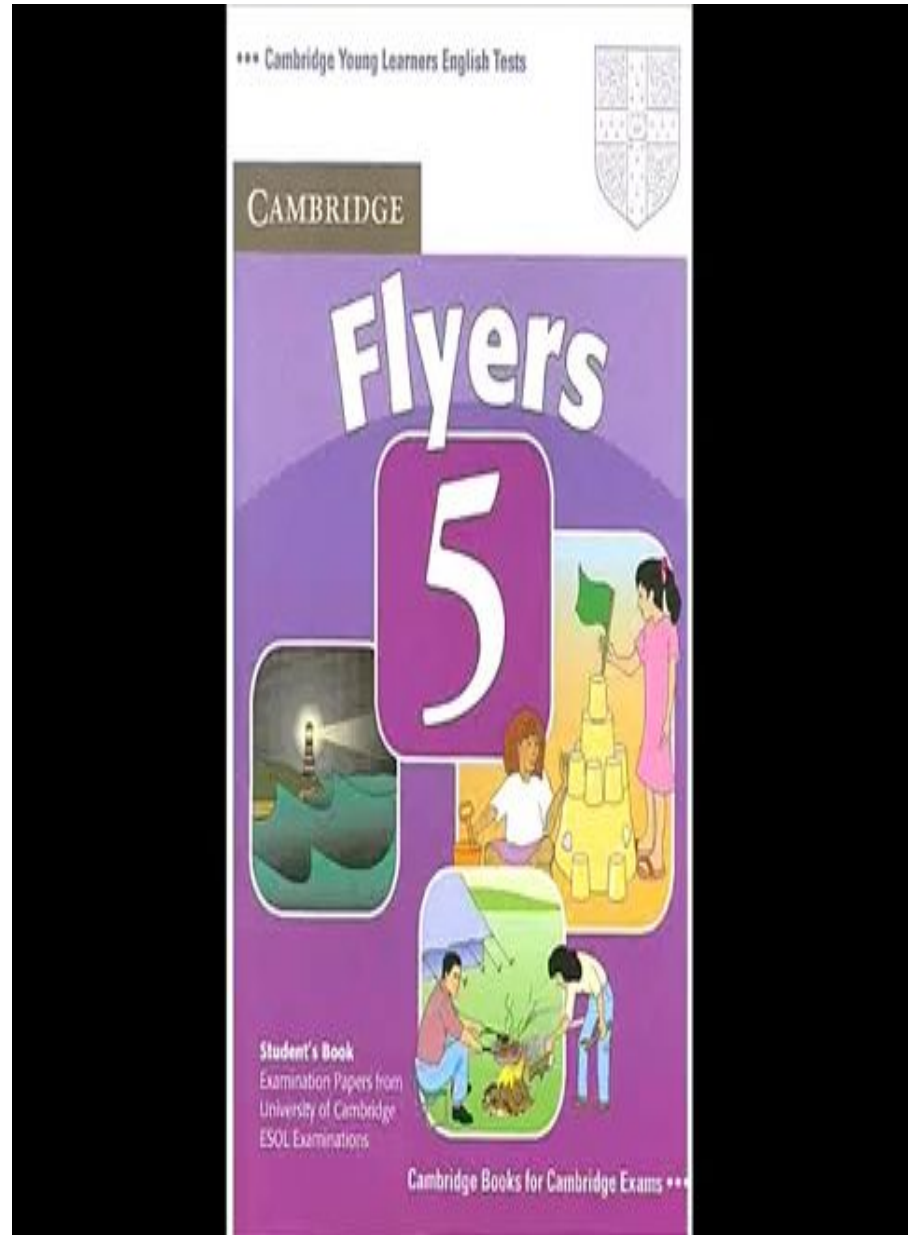

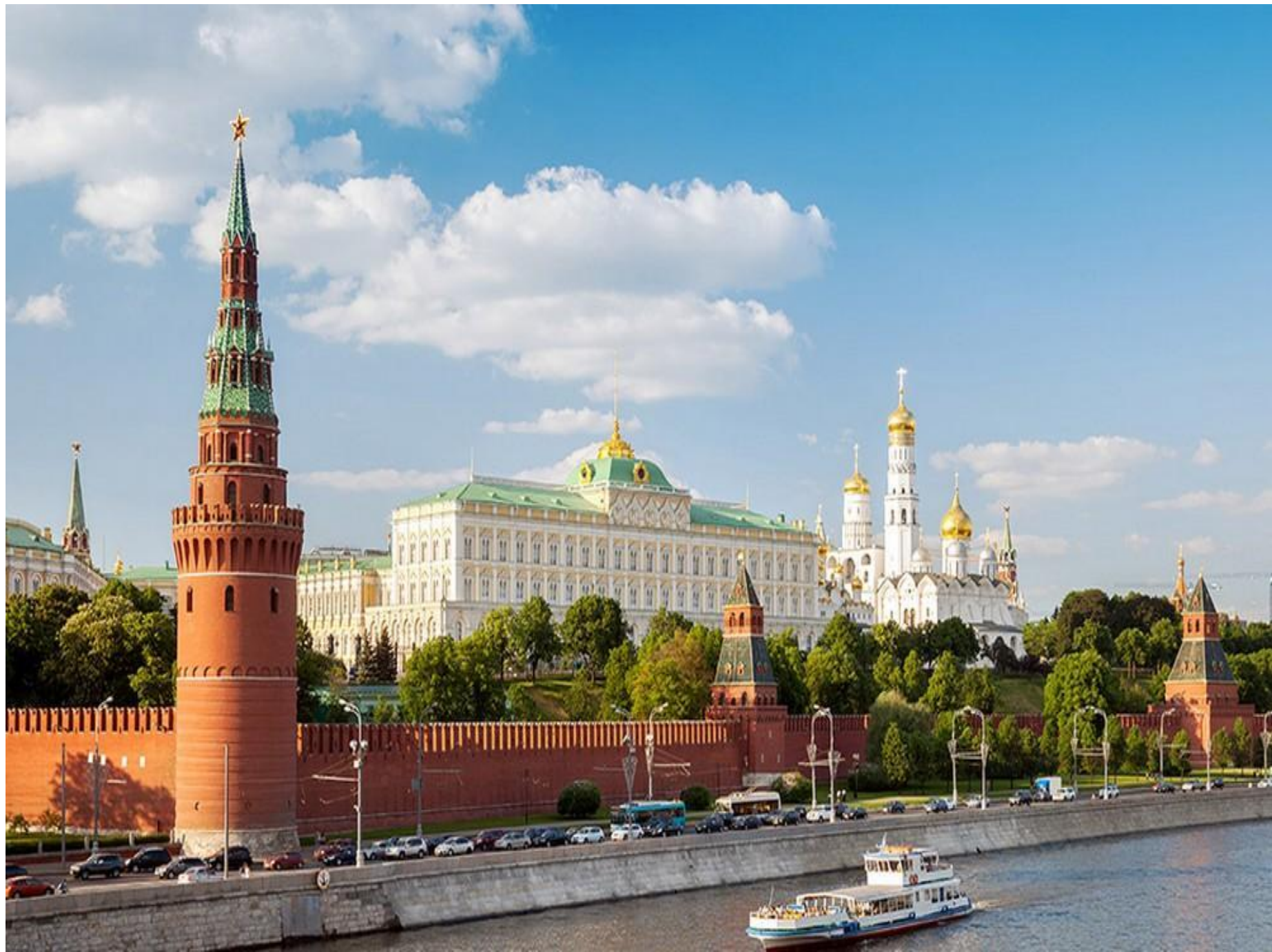
How I spent my summer vacation.
