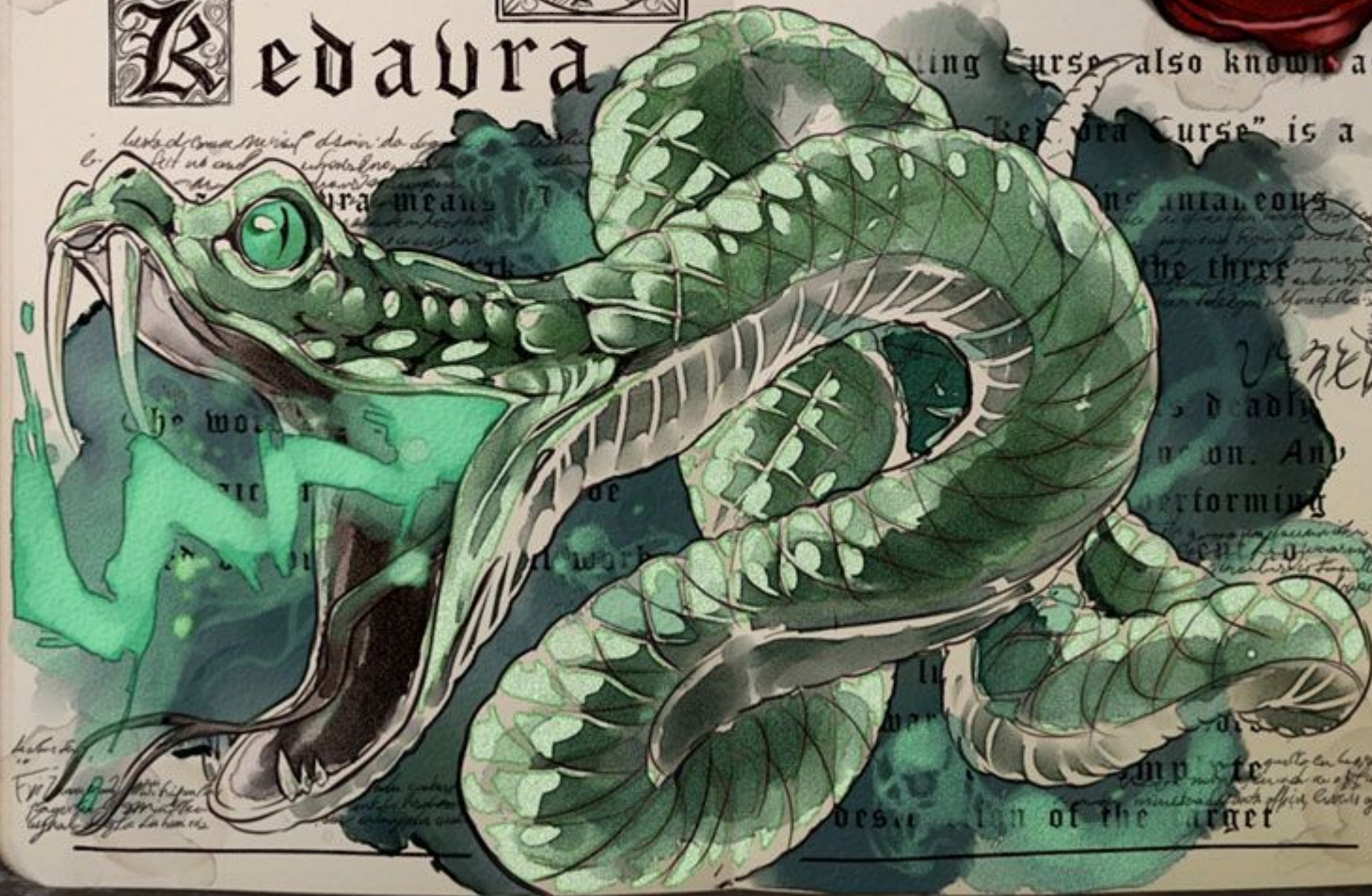

The most basic form of Occlumency involves
clearing one's mind – making it "blank and
empty" – in order to prevent a Legilimens
from perceiving one's emotions and thoughts.

Advanced Occlumency involves
controlling only the thoughts,
feelings, and memories that would
be dangerous if it is an Occlumens

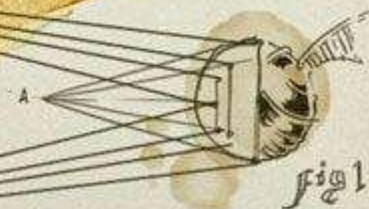
Golden Snitch

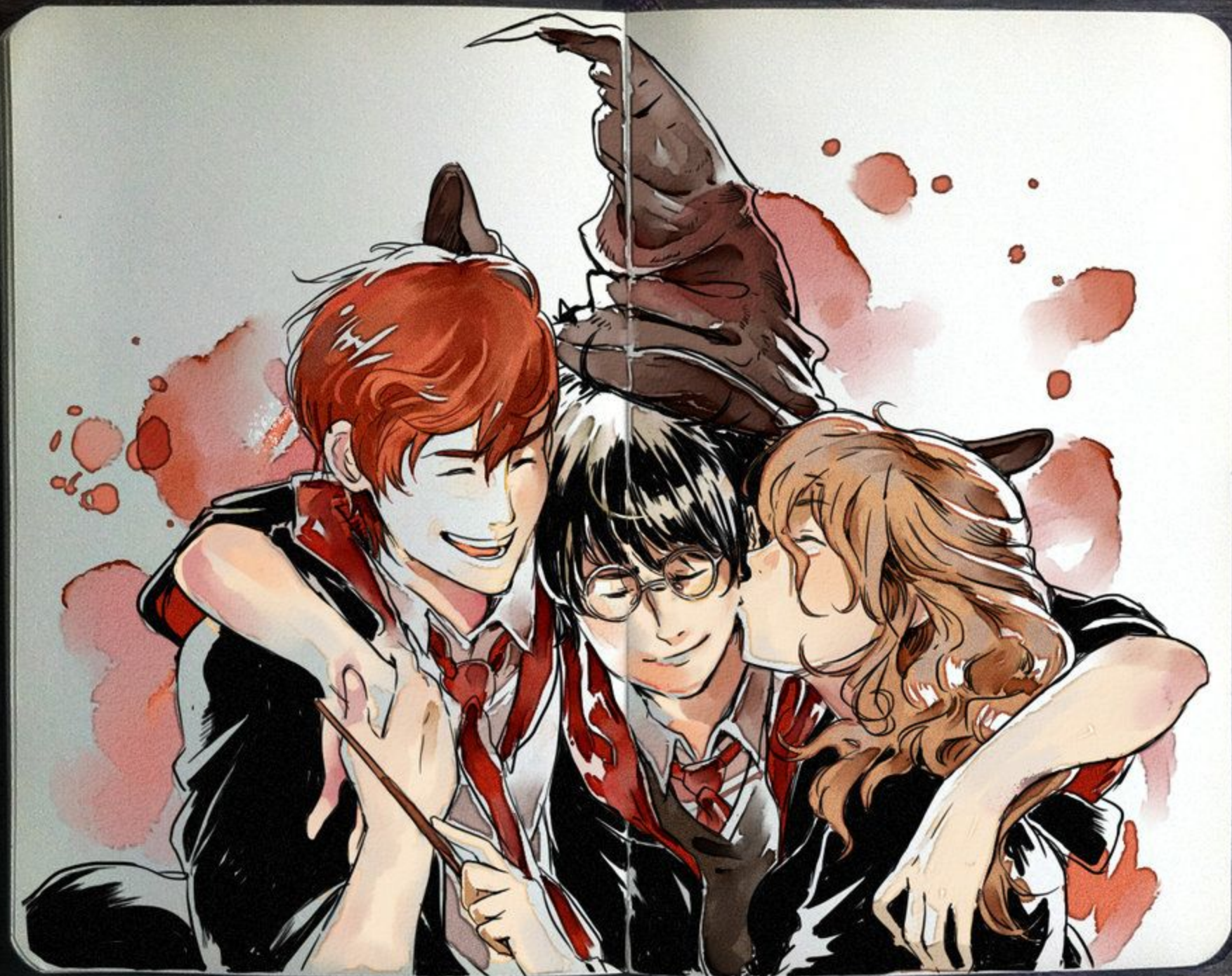

To successfully perform this curse, merely uttering the incantation is not enough. The wizard or witch must possess a deep desire to cause the victim pain. *Ripless Slapicoll*

The pain caused by the Cruciatus Curse is described as worse than "one thousand white-hot knives, boring into the skin." This pain can cause permanent mental injury if exposed to for prolonged time.

Presumably, such permanent effects are not uncommon if the victim is exposed to a particularly intense course for a long period.



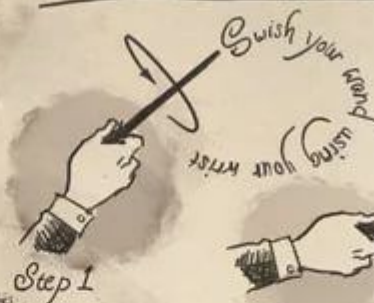

Wingardium Leviosa

The Levitation Charm is one of the most powerful spells learnt by any young witch. With the charm, a wand or wizard's hat can be made to fly or levitate in the air.



This levitation spell uses two specific body movements (a swish and flick), and correctly speaking the magic spell words: Wingardium Leviosa.

The Levitation Charm was first developed in the 17th century, and warlock Hobart is credited with its creation. On 16 June 1544, Hobart performed the spell on a large crowd of people, among which was the young girl, Miss Warlock. He did not, to his surprise, find the maiden levitating. Instead, she was possessed by a public demon. Hobart, in his own revolutionary spirit, decided to use the charm on himself. He climbed onto the roof of his local church and, as he leapt and, having cast the spell, was left hovering in mid-air.

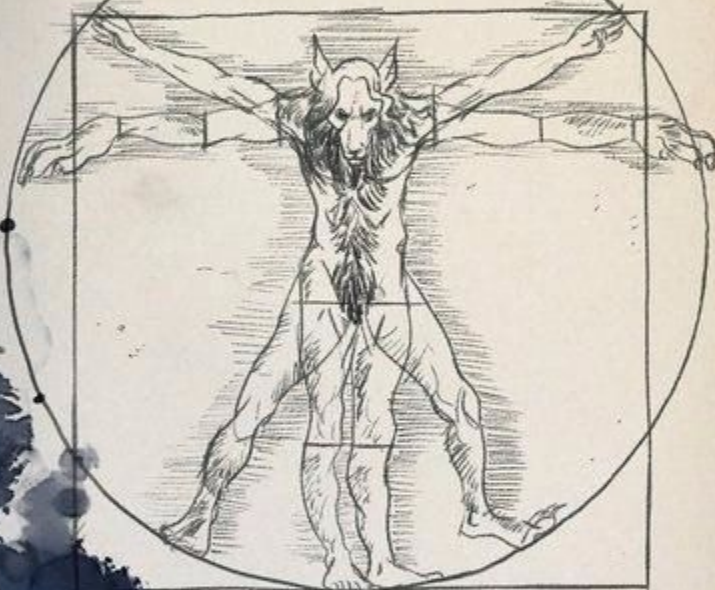
