Hold the wand horizontally for several seconds before advancing

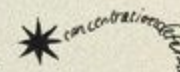

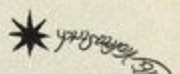

Complete concentration and focus directed through your wand is crucial to execute a lightning spell. Direction of focus is the first part of solid incantations. Inability to block outside distractions during spellcasting will prevent an effective power through your wand

Description

Occlumency is the art of warping
one's mind to prevent Legilimens



The most basic form of Occlumency involves
clearing one's mind – making it "blank and
empty" – in order to prevent a Legilimens
from perceiving one's emotions and thoughts.

Advanced Occlumency involves
controlling not only the thoughts,
but also the memories that would
betray one's mind. It is an Occlumens
goal to prevent Legilimens to believe;

It is the size of a walnut and it's always made of gold. The reason its color is yellow is because it's the hardest color for the human eye to notice, thus making it even more challenging to catch.

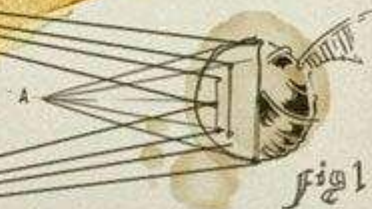

Dementors



Description

A Dementor is a creature of Dark Magic. There are many ways to defend against them, but the most effective is the Patronus Charm. The spell is difficult to cast, and requires a great deal of concentration and emotional strength. It is not possible to cast the spell if the caster is afraid or sad.



Although their numbers are small, they are very dangerous. They feed on the happiness and memories of their victims. If a victim is killed by a Dementor, their soul is trapped in a state of eternal suffering. The only way to free a soul is by using the Patronus Charm. This is why the Ministry of Magic has placed Dementors in Azkaban, to guard the prisoners. It is a very expensive, time-consuming, and troublesome task.

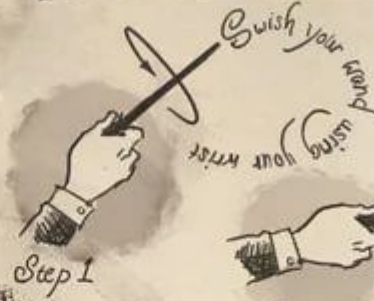

Wingardium Leviosa

The Levitation Charm is one of the most powerful spells in the wizarding world. It is a charm that causes objects to levitate. It is one of the spells learnt by any young witch or wizard. With the charm, a wand can be used to make things fly.



This levitation spell requires two specific body movements (a swish and flick), and correctly speaking the magic spell words: Wingardium Leviosa.



The Levitation Charm was first developed in the 17th century, and warlock Robert Hobbart is credited with its invention. On 16th October 1644, Hobbart performed the charm on a large crowd of people, among which was a young girl named Alice Warlock. Hobbart was not, to his surprise, a maiden. He was a public demon. Hobbart performed his own revolutionary charm on himself. He climbed onto the roof of his local church and, as he leapt and, having cast the spell, was left hovering in mid-air.

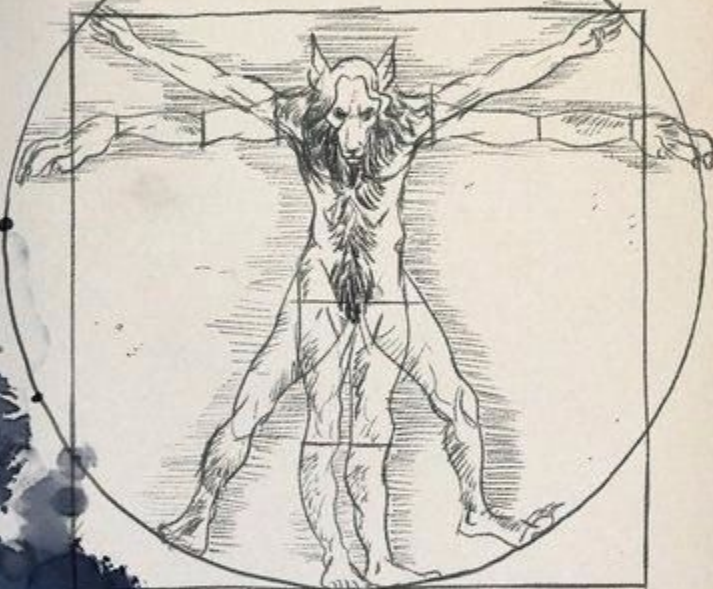
