- What a robot is
- How robots have developed
- If you would like a robot in your home and why
- What role robots will play in our society later this century



You are going to give a talk about shopping. You will have to start in 1,5 minutes and speak for not more than 2 minutes (10-12 sentences).

• Remember to say:


- what types of shops you know;

- You have to talk continuously.




You are going to give a talk about art. You will have to start in 1,5 minutes and speak for not more than 2 minutes (10-12 sentences).
