## SUMMER

Summer is the season between spring and autumn

North of The Equator	South of The Equator
JUNE	DECEMBER
JULY	JANUARY
AUGUST	FEBRUARY



## AUTUMN FALL

Autumn is the season between summer and winter.

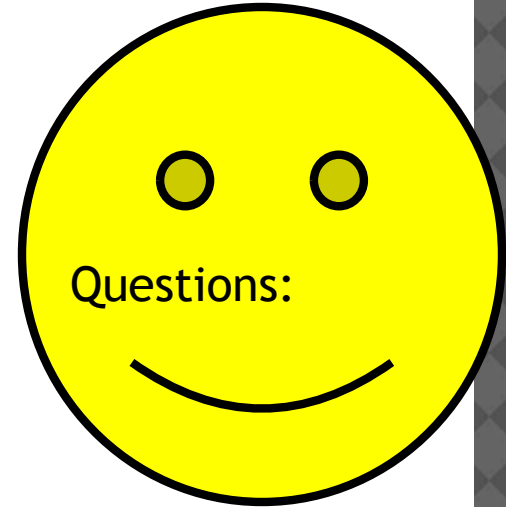
North of The Equator	South of The Equator

NOVEMBER	MAY



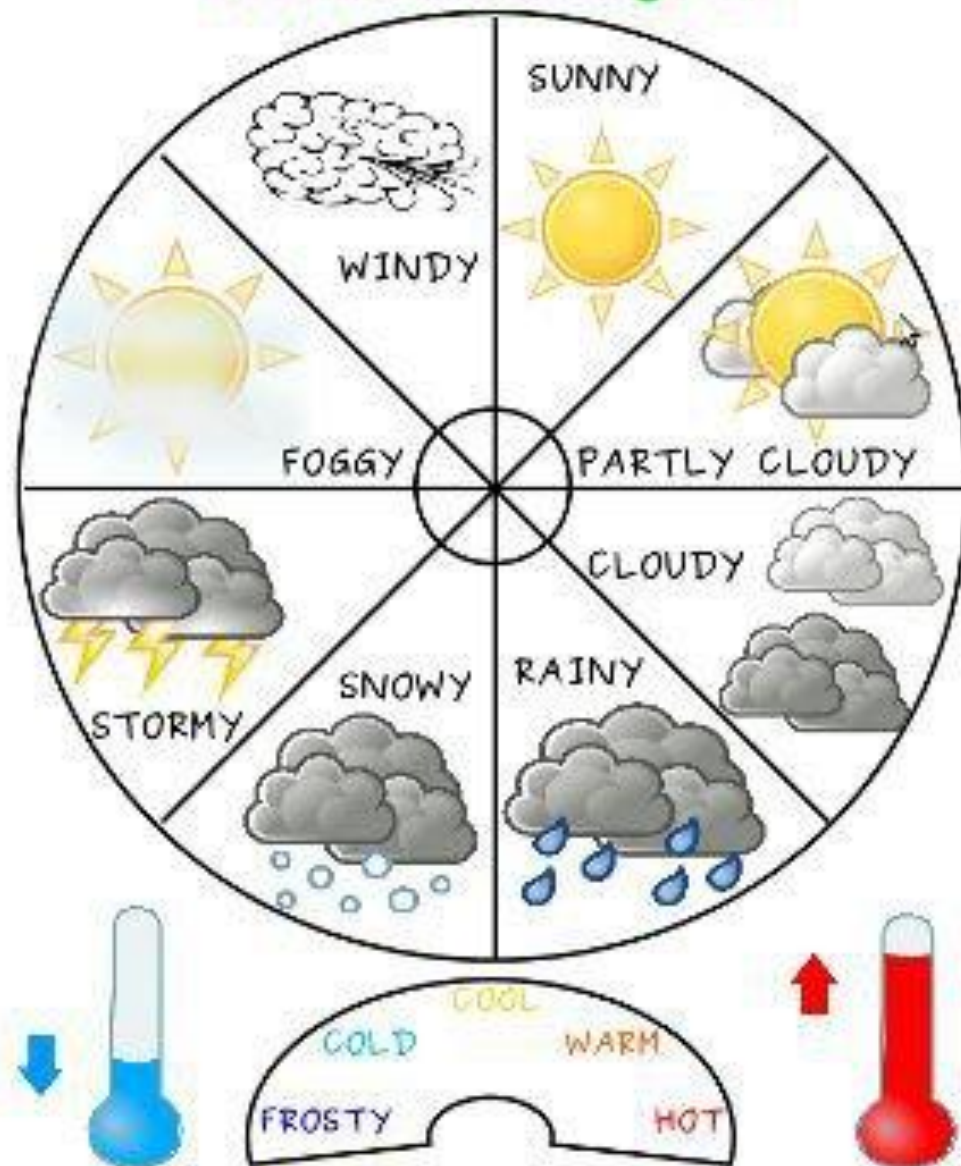
## WINTER
