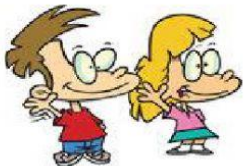

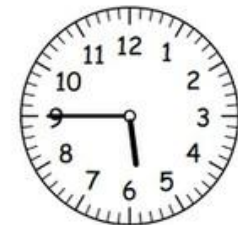
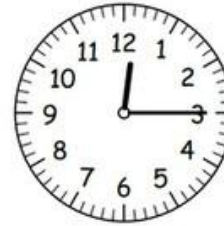

Autumn is the season between summer and winter.

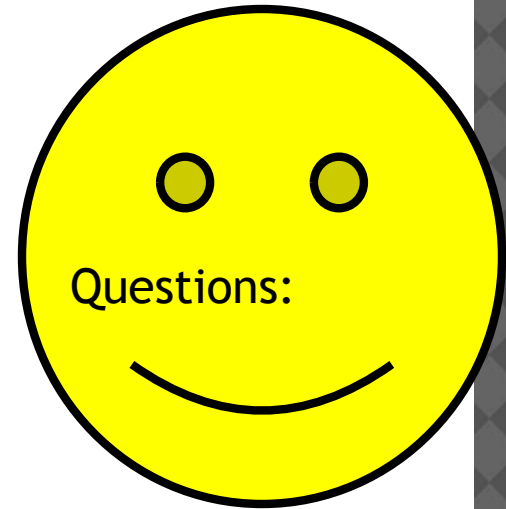
North of The Equator	South of The Equator

WINTER

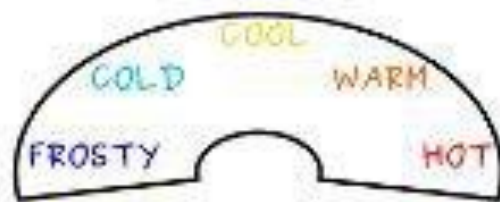
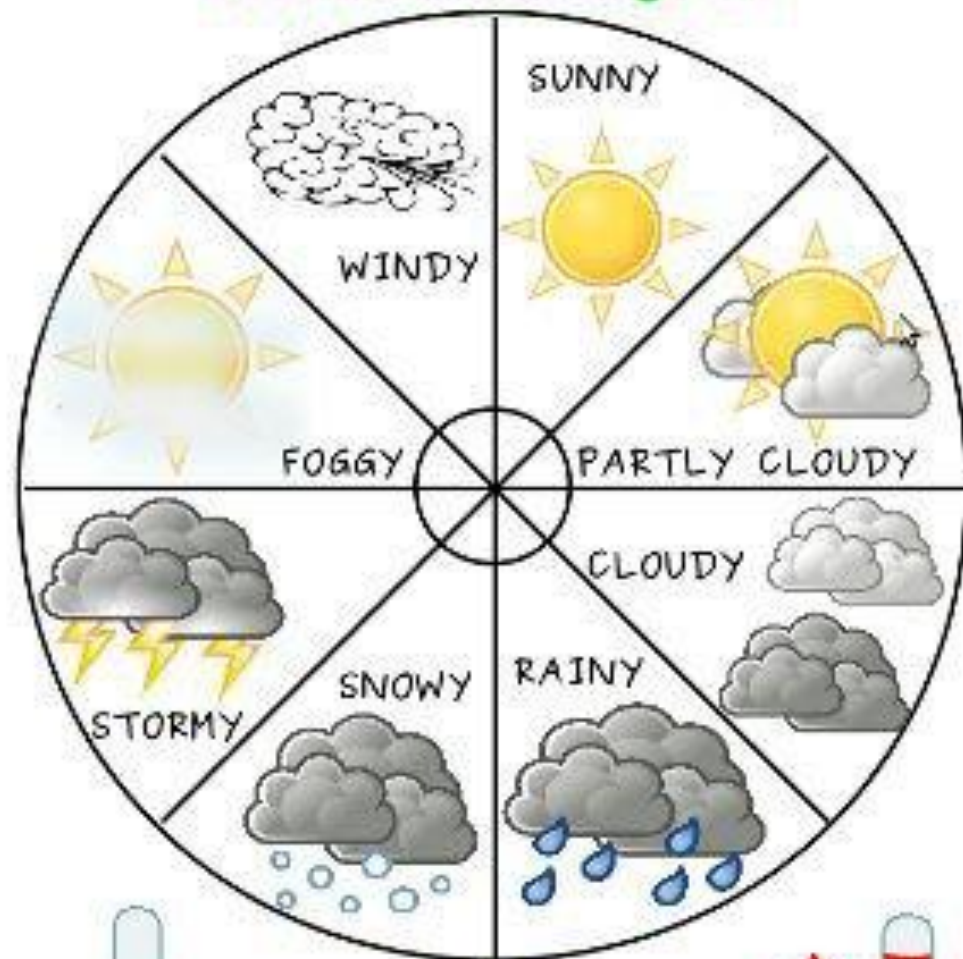
Winter is the season between autumn and spring.
