Do lions eat fish?

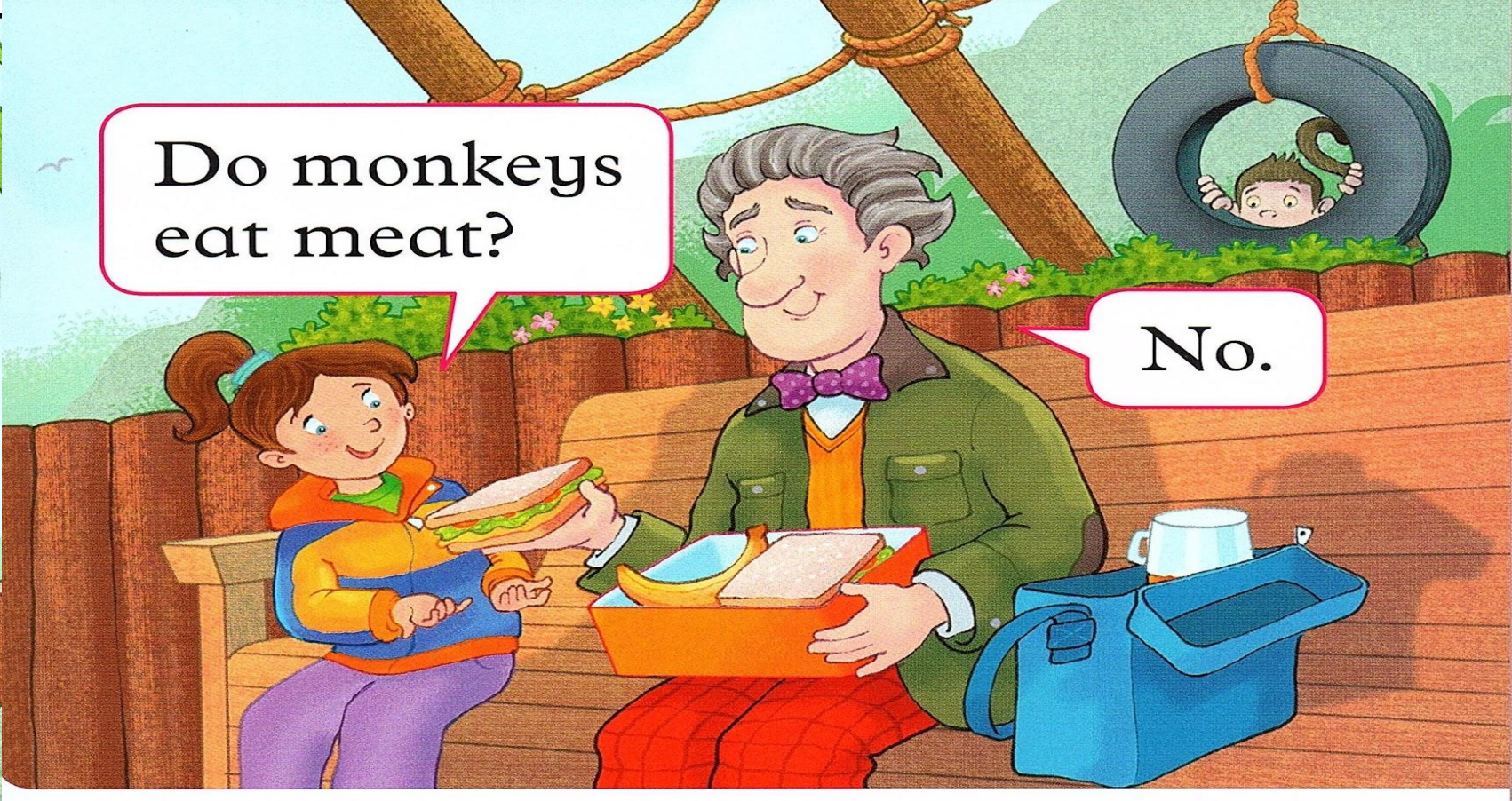
No. Lions don't eat fish. Lions eat meat.



Can you see the monkeys?

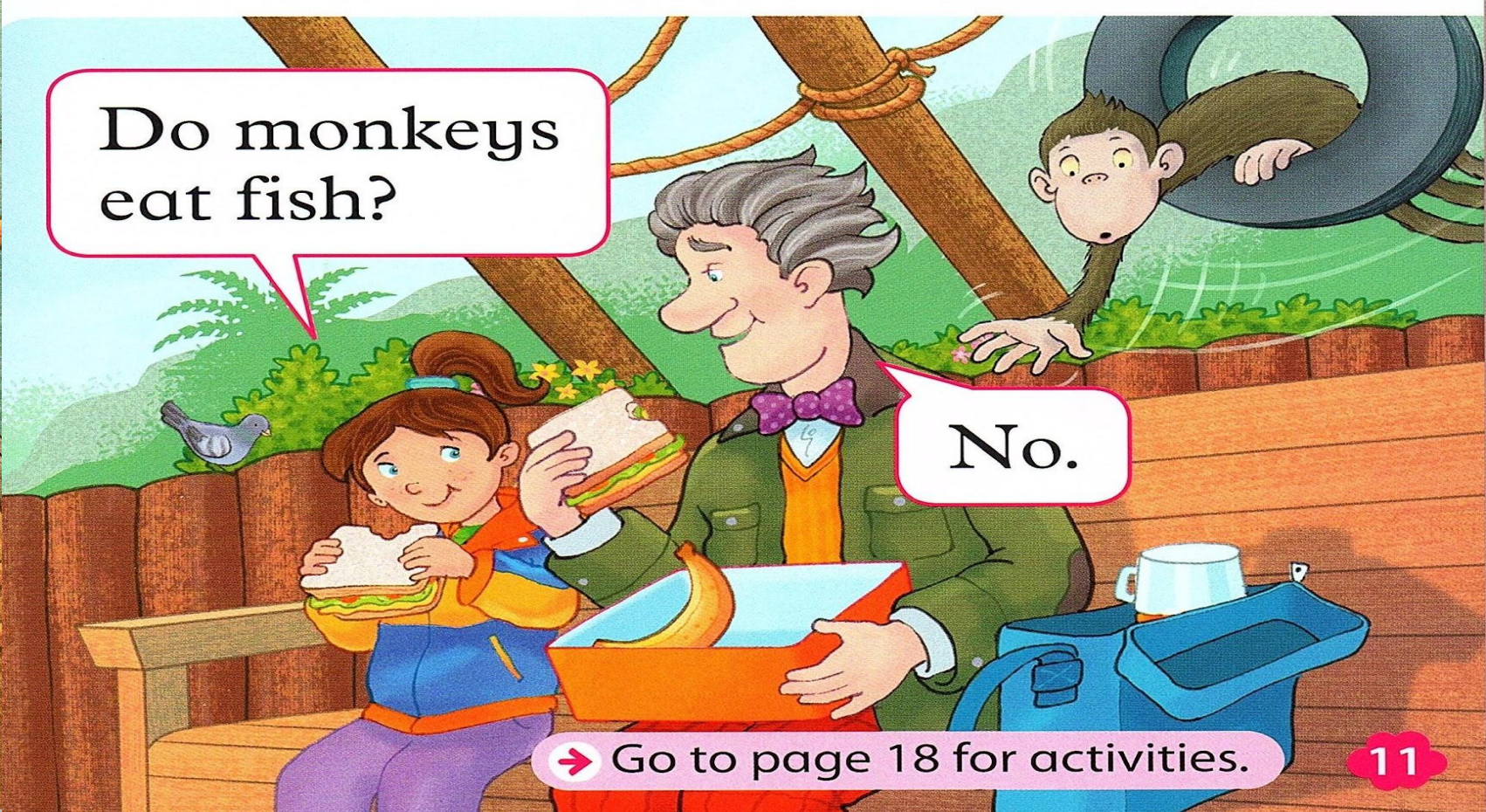


Yes. The monkeys are in the tree.
