

Plural of Nouns

Rules

To make the plural we usually add -s to the noun.

book | books pen | pens

With nouns ending in -s, -sh, -ch, -x or -o, we add the suffix -es.

class | classes box | boxes arch | arches tomato | tomatoes With nouns ending in a consonant and -y, the -y goes and we add -ies.

country [] countries baby [] babies

With nouns ending in -f or -fe, the -f or -fe goes and we add -ves.

knife | knives | leaf | leaves


Plural of Nouns

Rules


Irregular nouns do not follow the rules above. We make their plurals in various ways.
