ZERO CONDITIONAL



IF + Present Simple, Present Simple.

Usage

To talk about things that are always true, like a scientific fact



If you freeze water, it turns into ice.



- And, if you heat water at 100 degrees, it boils.
- If students miss an exam, the professor fails them.
- If my wife has a cold, I usually catch it.
- I get tired if I work too much.
- If I'm late for dinner, they start eating without me.

First Conditional



IF + Simple Present, Simple Future

(S + will/won't + V(bare form))

Usage

To talk about possibilities in the present or in the future



- If it rains, I will stay at home.
- If I wake up late, I will miss the bus.





- And, if it's sunny, we'll go to the park.
- If Juan leaves, Paula will be sad.
- If I find your email, I will send you the picture.
- If you study hard, you will pass your exams.

SECOND CONDITIONAL



IF+ Past Simple, Present Conditional

(To be: use WERE) (would/wouldn't + Verb (bare form)).

Usage

Imaginary situations in the present or future


Examples

If I won a million dollars, I would buy a new car.



- If I were you, I would quit smoking.
- If I were the president, I would lower taxes.
- They would stay longer if they had more time.
- If I won a million dollars, I could stop working.
- If I had more free time, I could travel around the world.

If I were you...



You imagine yourself in the position or situation of the other person. It is used **TO GIVE ADVICE**.





Why If I were and not If I was?

This is the SUBJUNCTIVE mood which is used for HYPOTHETICAL situations. It is a condition which is contrary to fact (the fact is, I am NOT you). With TO BE, use WERE for all subjects in the SUBJUNCTIVE.







I would be careful if I were you.

THIRD CONDITIONAL



IF + Past Perfect, Perfect Conditional

(Would/wouldn't + have + Past Participle)

Usage

Imaginary situations in the past

Examples

- If I had got a gold medal, I would have been happy.
- If I had met Susan last week, I would have given her the book.
- If the weather had been good, we would have gone water-skiing.
- If you had got (gotten-US) up earlier, you would have caught the earlier train.


