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





## Soft skills


The American National Association of Colleges and Employers organized an investigate of 260 organizations (including Chevron, IBM according to Forbes), which resulted in the following five soft skills that are considered the most valuable in the staff listed below in order of importance:

- 1. Ability to **work in a team**
- 2. Ability to communicate with people in the organization and outside
- 3. Ability to plan, organize and prioritize (time management)
- 4. Ability to make decisions and solve problems (complex task)
- 5. Ability to search and process information







## **IQ or EQ** What's More Important For Success In Your Career?



#### Research conducted by Harvard University,

the Carnegie Foundation and Stanford Research Center, has all concluded that 85% of job success comes from having well-developed soft skills and people skills,

and only 15% of job success comes from technical skills and knowledge (hard skills).

- IQ is the brain


