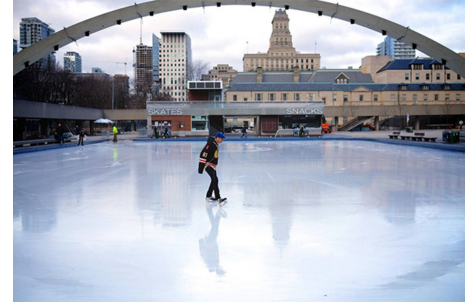

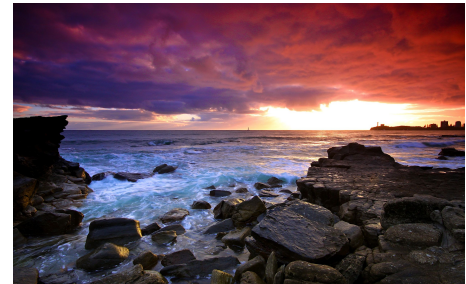

# WORD FOCUS

**WHY DO WE USE ADVERBS?  
HOW TO FORM AN ADVERB?**

## ADVERBS.

BAD (ПЛОХОЙ) + **LY** = BAD**LY** (ПЛОХО)

QUICK ( БЫСТРЫЙ) + **LY** = QUICK**LY** (БЫСТРО)

DAY ( ДЕНЬ) + **LY** = DAI**LY**( ЕЖЕДНЕВНО)

**BUT!**

FAST = БЫСТРО, БЫСТРЫЙ

HIGH = ВЫСОКО, ВЫСОКИЙ

HARD = ТРУДНО, ТРУДНЫЙ



## *ADVERBS.*

There are some adjectives ending in -LY too:

- **FRIENDLY**
- **LIVELY**
- **LONELY**
- **LOVELY**
