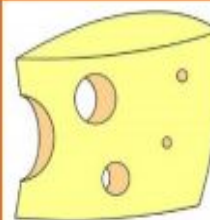

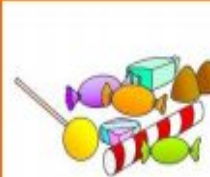
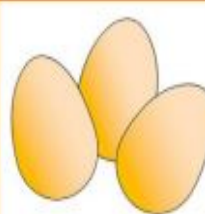

There **aren't** + plural noun

There **aren't** any pens here.

There **isn't** + uncountable noun
