Then, she **left** (leave) the library and slowly **climbed**
(climb) the stairs. **made** **went**

The stairs (make) a creaking sound as she
(go) up them.

Upstairs, she **investigated** (**investigate**) the bedrooms one
by one: **covered**
dust **walked** (**cover**) the beds and dressers, but
no ghost (**walk**) there.

Clarissa **sighed** (**sigh**) and **became** (**become**) certain
that **haunted** **hurried**
no ghost (**haunt**) this house, and so she
..... (**hurry**)
back downstairs and out of the front door of the house.

Finally, as she **walked** (**walk**) away from the house, she **looked**
(**look**) back. **was** **waved**
there (**went**) a ghost in the doorway. The ghost
(**wave**) goodbye
to her, smiling, and then (**go**) back into the house.
