подлежащее + *have to* + основной глагол +  
второстепенные члены предложения

I *have to* get up early.- Мне приходится  
вставать рано.

Rose *has to* breakfast every day.

## HAD TO

I ***had to*** get up early yesterday.

The bus was at 5 o'clock.

Мне пришлось встать рано вчера.

Автобус был в 5 часов.

# FUTURE SIMPLE

I'll *have to* get up early tomorrow. The train is at 7 o'clock in the morning.

Мне придется встать рано завтра. Поезд

7 часов утра.
