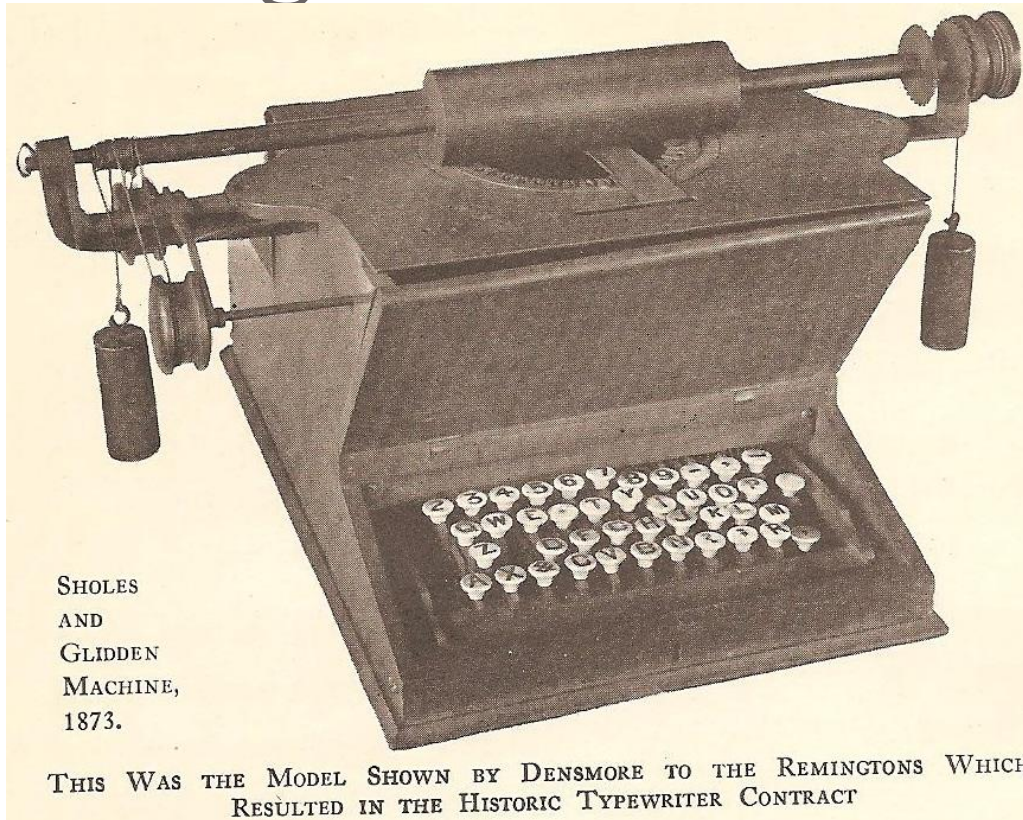
The first typewriter was

Fivizzano

In 1863 Christopher
Sholes & Samuel
Soule were invented
progenitor of the
modern typewriter

The patent for the invention was received in 1868. The first version of their machines had two rows of keys with numbers and alphabetical arrangement of letters from A to Z
