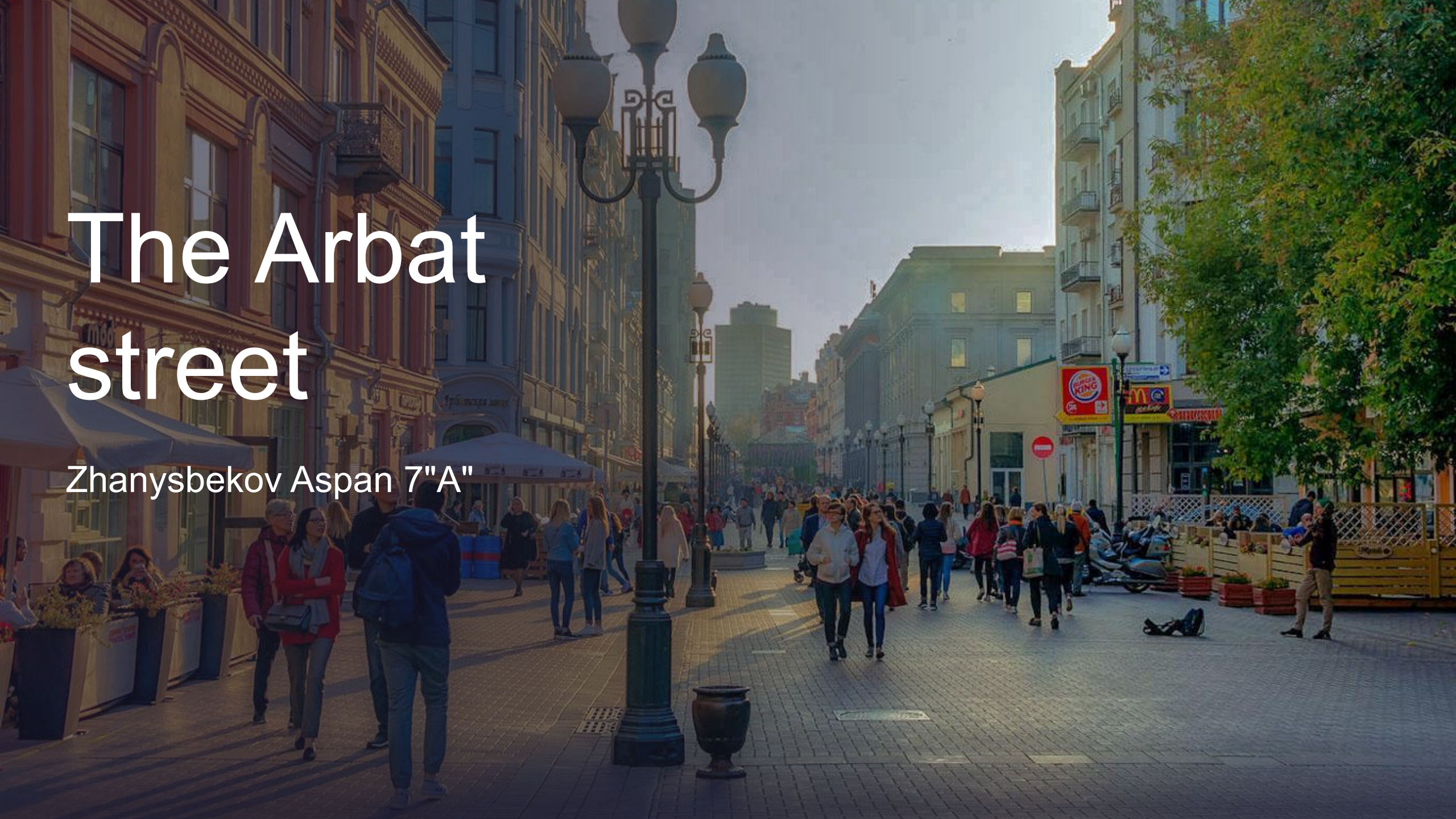


# The Arbat street

# Where situated Arbat street



- The Arbat Street is located in the center of Moscow, he was founded a long time ago, Arbat was included in the chronicle of 1493. It is considered one of the oldest streets in Moscow

# Why Arbat?

- The word "Arbat" itself is of Arabic origin (from "arbad") and means "suburb". It is assumed that the word "arbad" could have come to Moscow from Eastern merchants who already came to Moscow to trade.



# Who lived on the arbat?

- At various times, Pushkin, Gogol, Tolstoy, Saltykov-Shchedrin, the Aksakov brothers, Chekhov, Blok lived or repeatedly visited the Arbat



# Pedestrian Arbat

- The Arbat became pedestrian by 1986: traffic was completely blocked, all underground systems were dug up and the street was improved, flowers were planted, benches for recreation and lanterns were put up. Well, today Arbat is still a walking street, 1.2 kilometers long
