The *imperative* is used to give commands and orders.

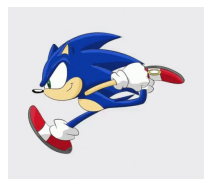
EXAMPLES:

- *Open the door.*
- *Clean your shoes.*
- *Sit down.*

Or is used to make suggestions using *Let 's + main verb.*

EXAMPLES:

- *Let 's run.*
- *Let 's go to the beach.*
- *Let 's take a picture.*
