USA

- ▶ Americans think over the location of guests
- ▶ Don't make long pauses

- ▶ The Germans are very scrupulous in details
- ▶ Don't give business gifts

Italians dress beautifully and elegantly everywhere.



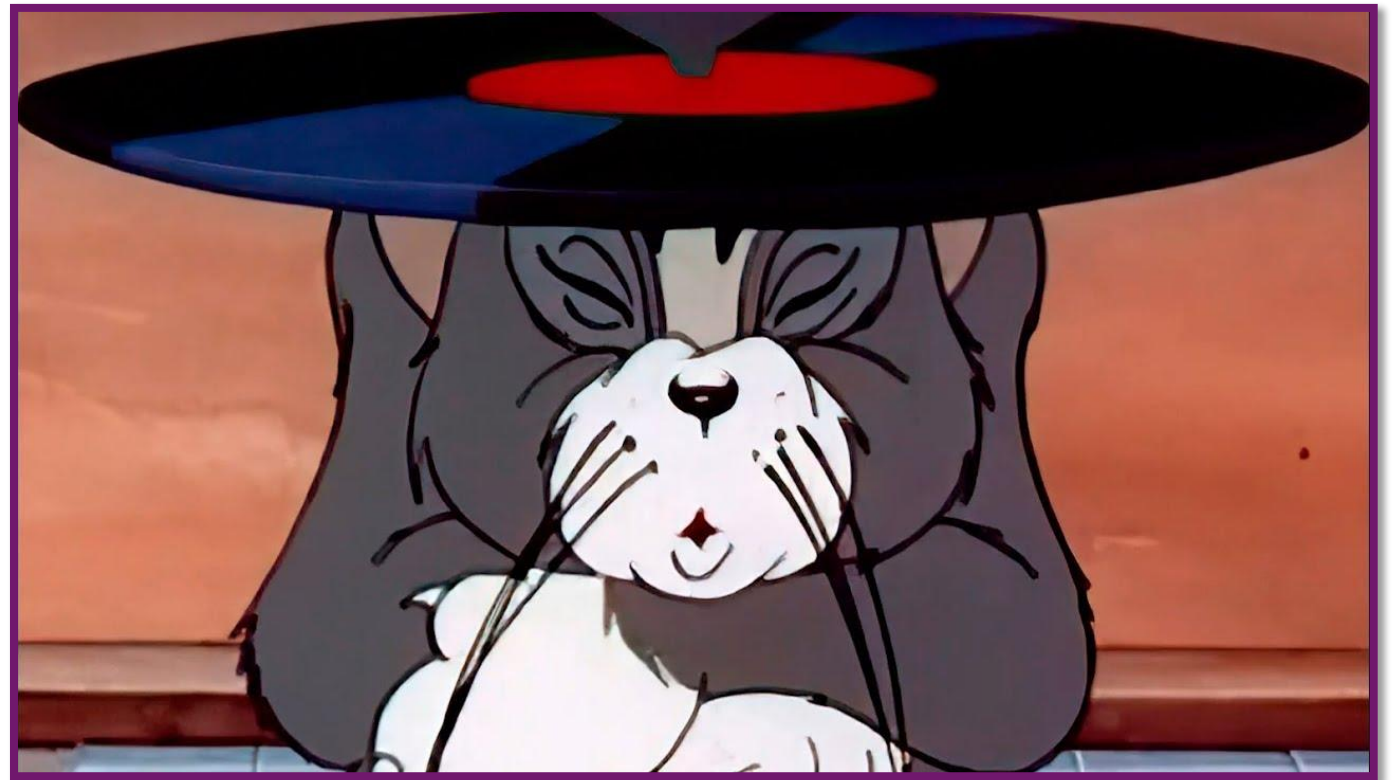
Features of business etiquette in Italy

- ▶ Business is a personal relationship



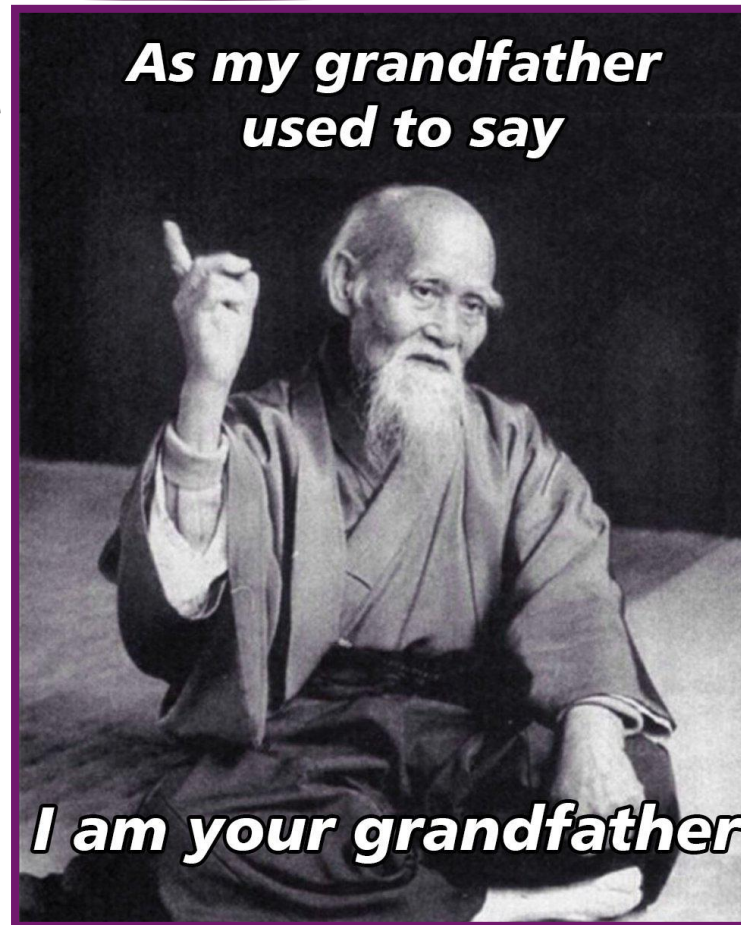
China

Features of business etiquette in China

- ▶ Make an appointment in advance
- ▶ You can't be late for meetings
- ▶ Chinese usually use handshakes
- ▶ Chinese restrain themselves
- ▶ Elders are respected
- ▶ Do not call by name



Japan

- ▶ Need a personal meeting
- ▶ Bow is a traditional form of greeting
- ▶ Exchange business cards
- ▶ You need to be patient
- ▶ Informal ties with their business partners

- ▶ The meeting begins and ends with handshakes
- ▶ Call by name and patronymic
- ▶ Organization of a buffet in the office
- ▶ Don't look at the phone
- ▶ Do not look below the chin
