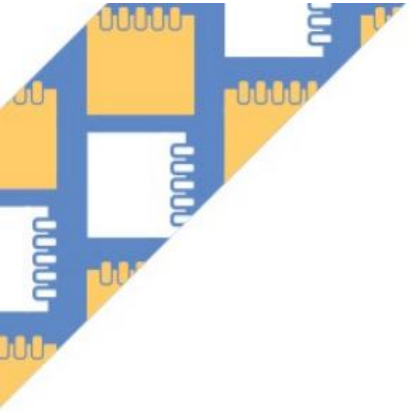


January

in the year.





It has 31 days.



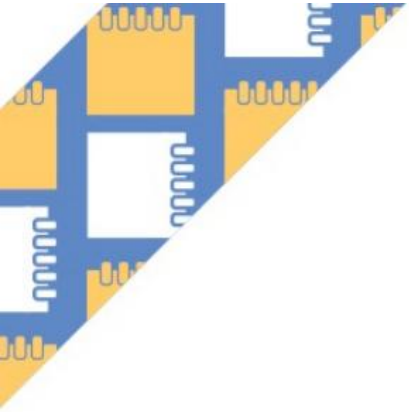

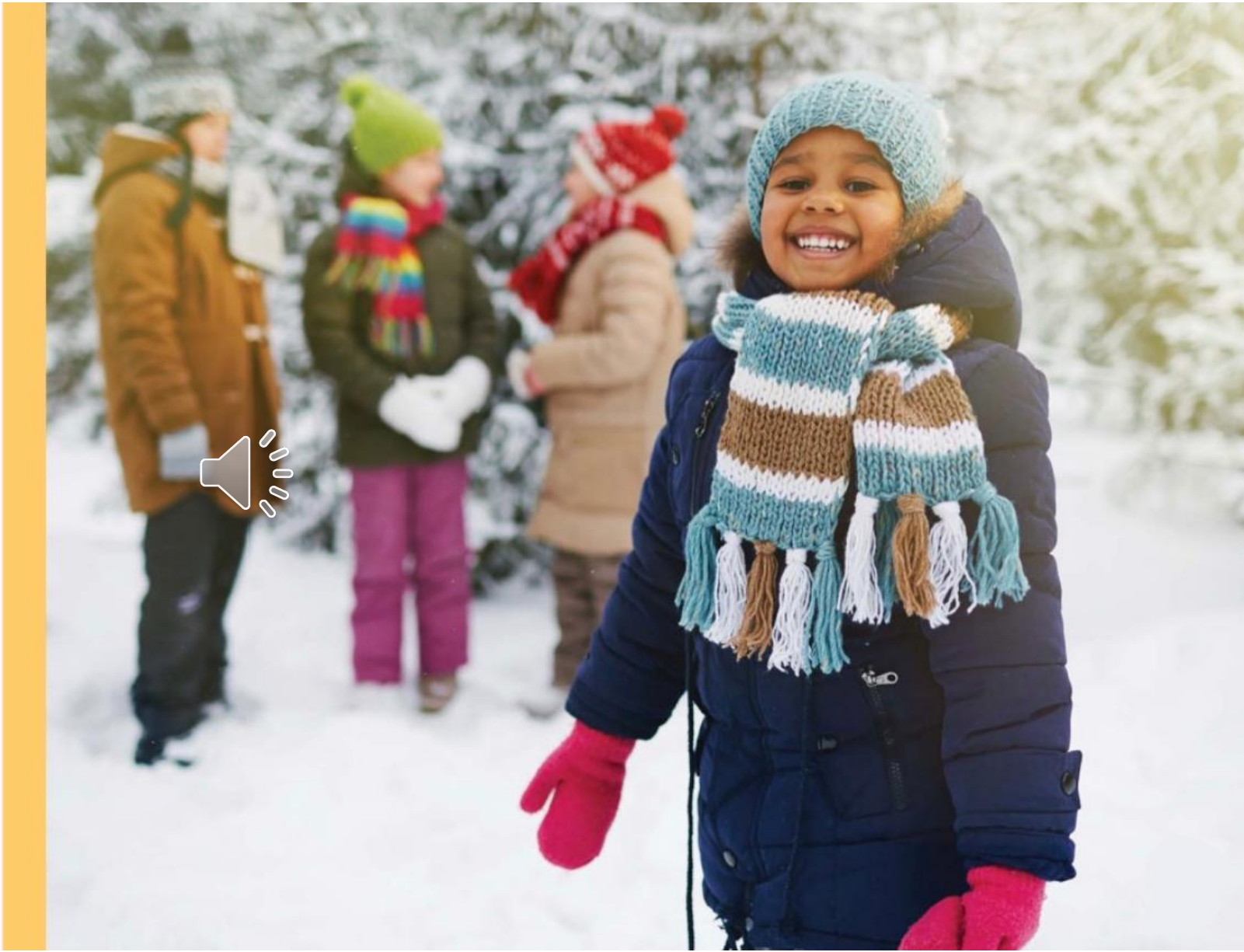


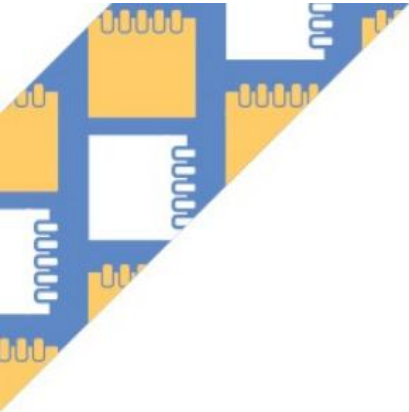
New Year's Day is the first day
of the year. Pete blows the horn!





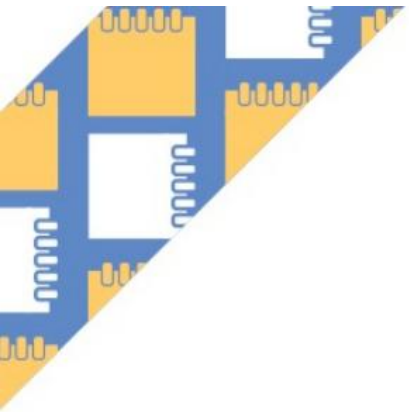
January can be cold. Tami wears a hat and mittens.
