LOCATION

Australia is in the **Southern Hemisphere**.

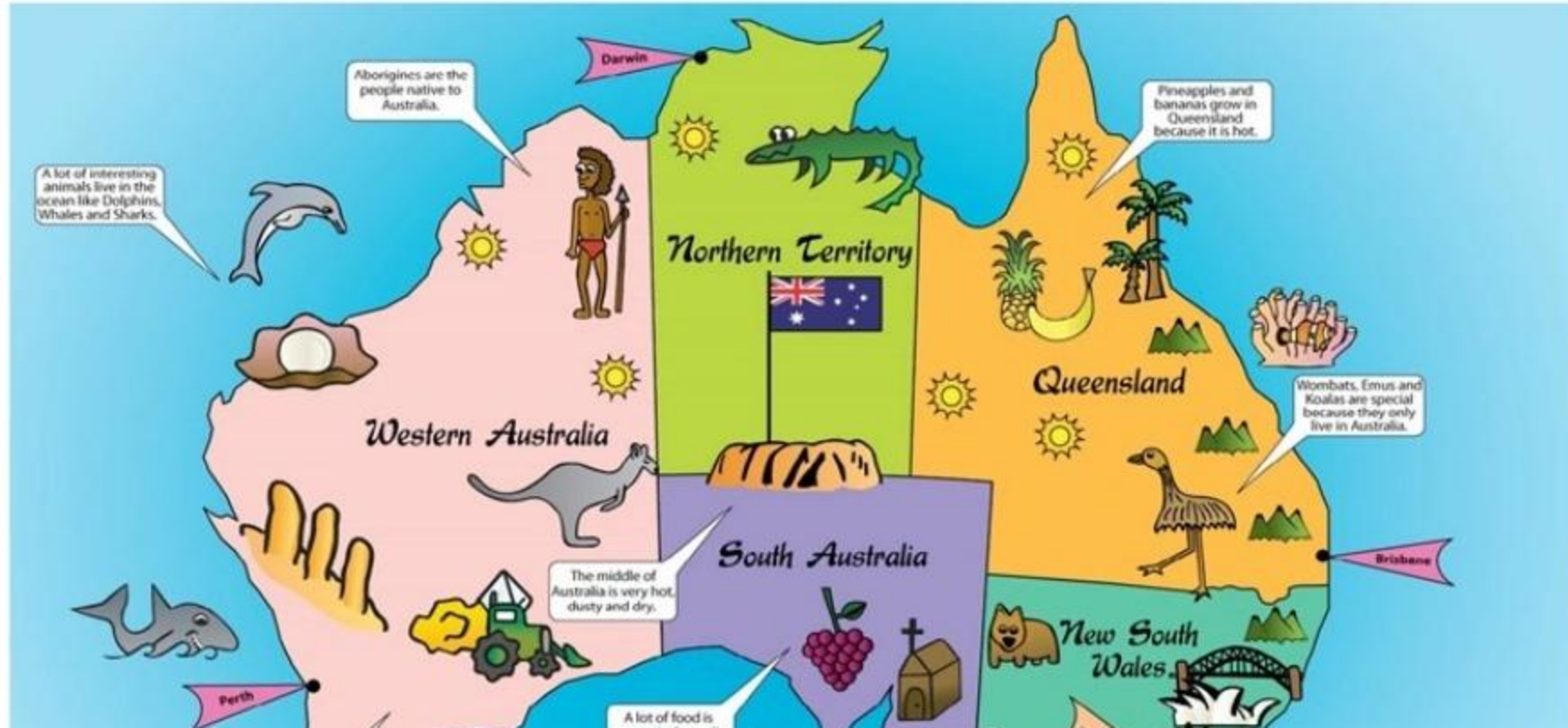
