The Day of the National Flag of Russia is celebrated annually on August 22.





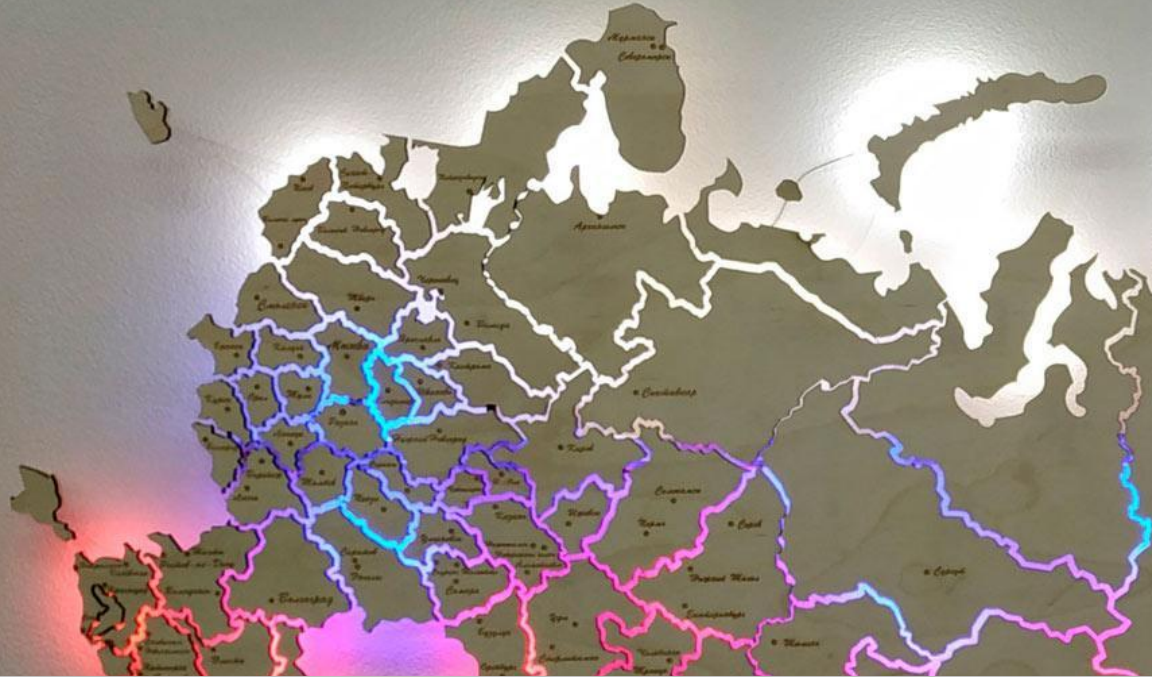
# COAT OF ARMS OF RUSSIA

*The Coat of Arms of Russia is the official state symbol of the Russian Federation; one of the main state symbols of Russia along with the National Flag of the Russian Federation and the National Anthem of the Russian Federation. The modern coat of arms was approved by the Decree of the President of the Russian Federation of November 30 , 1993 The State emblem of Russia is an image of a golden double-headed eagle on a red shield. The eagle is a symbol of invincibility and strength. The two-headed eagle, guarding the state, looks both to the West and to the East Over the eagle three crowns. The crown on the eagle's head is a symbol of legality, meaning that the country lives by legitimate honor.*

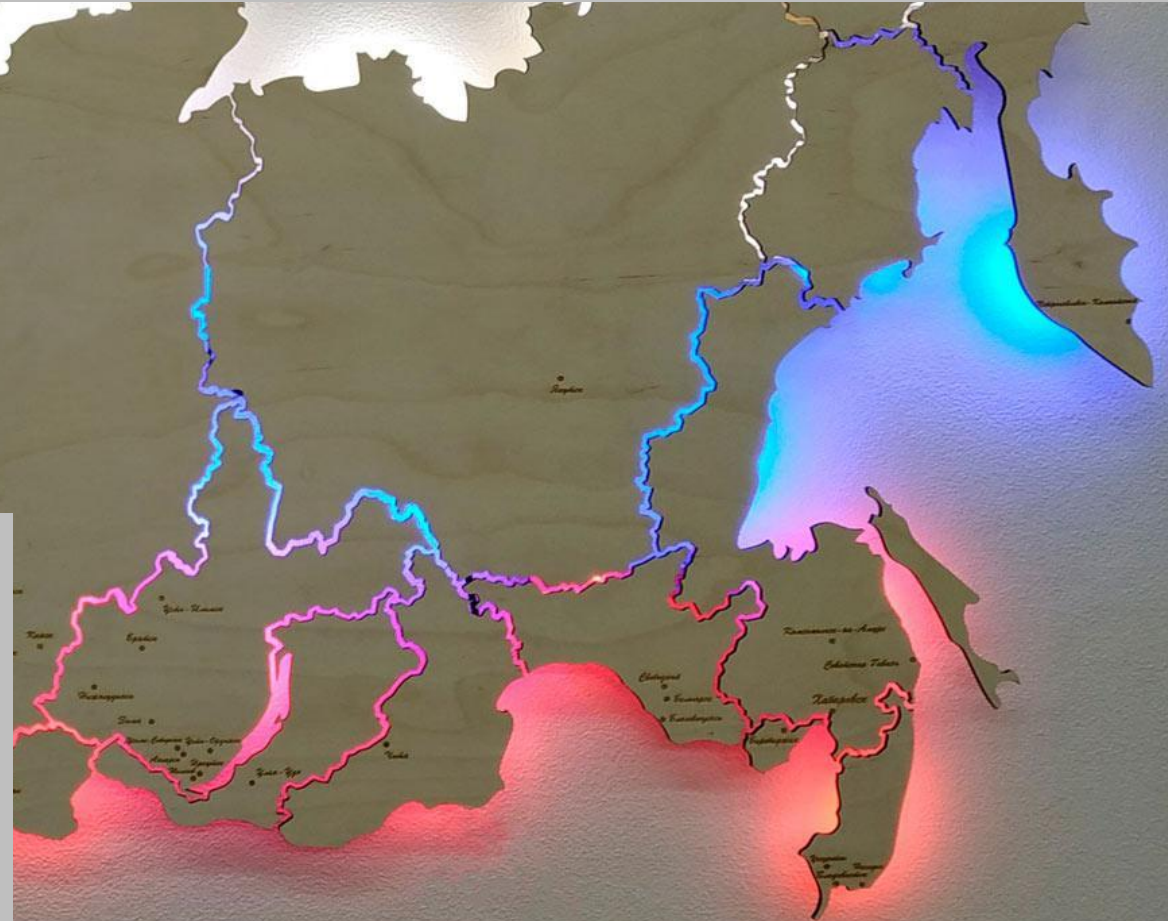


# Geographical location of Russia

# INDUSTRIAL ECONOMICS

Today, the Russian Federation is one of the leading powers in the world. According to its potential, the country's industry is able to establish the production of a wide range of goods that provide the most important areas of the population's life. Despite the severe systemic crisis of the 90s, accompanied by a significant decline in industrial production, a steady trend of growth and development has been recorded in this segment since the early 2000s. Russia closes the top four, behind China, the United States and India. The most developed branches of Russian industry are the oil and gas sector, ferrous and non-ferrous metallurgy, general and transport engineering, food production.

# Political system

**The Russian Federation - Russia is a democratic federal rule-of-law state with a republican form of government. The Russian Federation consists of republics, territories, regions, cities of federal significance, autonomous regions, autonomous districts - equal subjects of the Russian Federation. State power in the Russian Federation is exercised by the President of the Russian Federation, the Federal Assembly (the Federation Council and the State Duma), the Government of the Russian Federation, and the courts of the Russian Federation.**



# Sports in Russia



Russia is one of the leading sports powers in the world, and the victories of Russian athletes at the main tournaments of the planet from year to year only confirm this status. Various competitions are constantly held in the country, including the world-class Winter Olympics-2014 in Sochi, the Summer Universiade in Kazan-2013, three World championships and two European championships were held in 2016, and the World Football Championship was held in 2018, which covered 11 Russian cities.

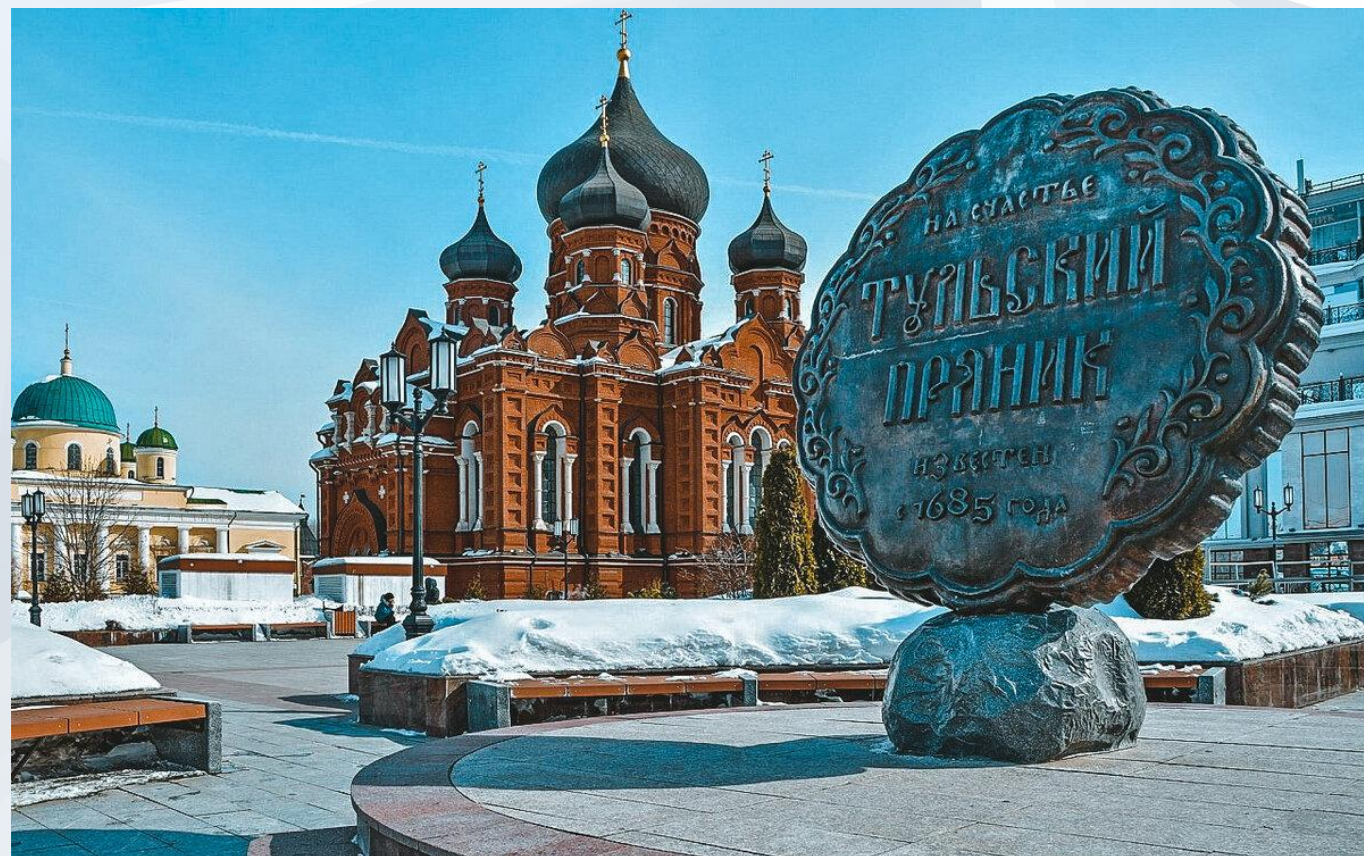

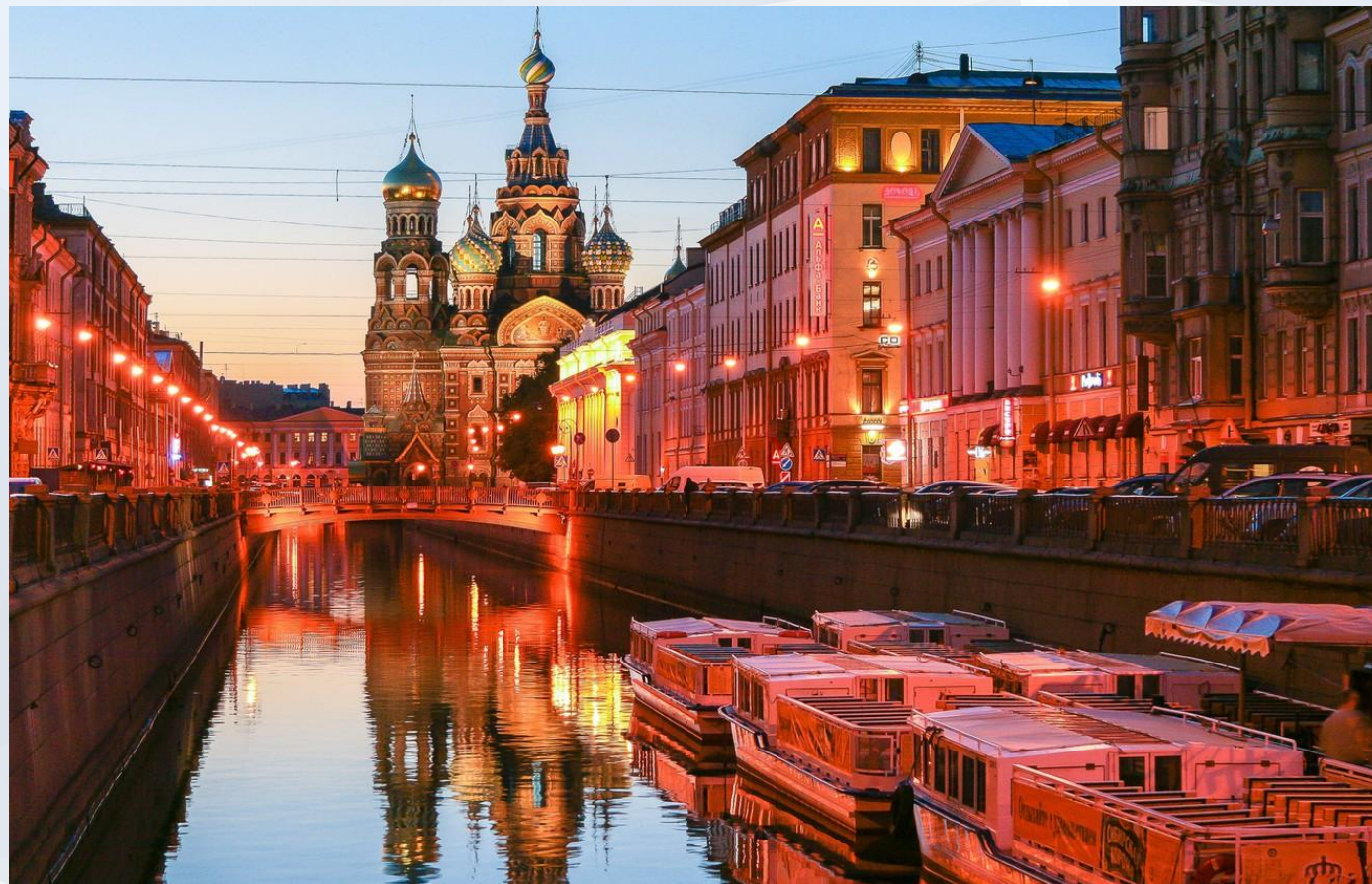
