SYMBOLS

The flag of Great Britain is red, white and blue. The British people call it “the Union Jack”



The coat of arms of Great Britain has a crown on the shield, because it's a monarchy. The shield is supported by the English lion and by the Unicorn of Scotland.



The Houses of Parliament

- It is a place where the British Government sits.
- It consists of three parts: the Royal Apartments, the House of Lords and the House of Commons.



Big Ben

- **Big Ben** is the nickname for the Great Bell of the clock at the north end of the Palace of Westminster in London, and often extended to refer to the clock and the clock tower.
