	would like	a new computer.
Can I	see	that one?
Can you	help	me?

I'd like = Я бы хотел

Use *would like* + noun = *Can I have* or *I want*.

Would like is polite.

Note:

I'd like a banana. = I want a banana now.

I like bananas. = I always like bananas.
