What can I do?




She could borrow some money from her friends.

Or she could ask for the money for a birthday present.






Situation 2

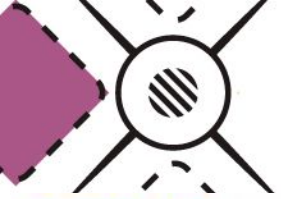
