Princess Anne is a member of the British royal family, the only daughter of Queen Elizabeth II. At the time of her birth, she was in third place in the order of succession to the throne; after Elizabeth's accession to the throne, she moved to second place. It is currently ranked fifteenth in the order of succession to the throne.

The youngest child and only daughter of Queen Elizabeth II, Anne has officially represented the British monarchy for 52 years, since she turned 18.

Princess Anne immediately after graduating from high school took up the duties of a member of the Royal House of Great Britain. These include meetings with politicians, public figures and others for various purposes, as well as participation in official ceremonies and events.

The princess devotes time to charity, leads the organization "Save the Children" and the Royal Princess Fund.

She actively fights for equality.

Member of the Royal Society and the Academy of Medical Sciences. Several educational institutions in England work under the patronage of the princess.

In addition, Princess Anne is a member of the International Olympic Committee.

Of the members of the British royal family, it was Princess Anne who most often visited Russia.

It was she who officially represented Great Britain at the Sochi Olympics.

In 1975, Anna did not allow herself to be kidnapped

Once the princess was driving home from a charity evening, when suddenly a Ford Escort blocked her way. An armed man jumped out of the car and opened fire, wounding the bodyguard, the driver and the journalist accompanying Anna (all the victims survived). The princess had one thing to do: to save herself. The kidnapper ordered her out of the car and demanded two million pounds in ransom. To which Anna casually and decisively declared: "What else! I don't have two million pounds."

Anna participated in the 1976 Olympics

The princess, on general terms, participated in the Montreal Olympics, as part of the UK equestrian team. Her partner, a horse named Goodwill, belonged personally to Queen Elizabeth.

Zambian President Nominated Anna for Nobel Peace Prize

Anna has been nominated for her work with Save the Children, which defends and advocates for the rights of children around the world. From 1970 to 2017, the princess headed the foundation, and is now its patron.

Anna gave up titles for her children to make their lives more normal

Anna decided that it would be better for everyone. “I think it will be easier for them that way. Titles have their drawbacks, for sure many will agree with me,” she said in an interview with Vanity Fair.

Here's what Anna has to say about pregnancy

In response to a question about how she felt and what she was doing while expecting her first child, Anna said that these months of her life were unbearably boring.

It should be noted that Anna has an amazing sense of style

Somehow in 2018, Anna appeared in public in a pair of Adidas sports glasses, which were very fashionable at that time, such were literally on all the catwalks.

There were cases when the princess took out of the closet outfits forty years ago. In the same 2018, she was seen wearing a suit that she first walked at the royal races in 1980.

Anna admits that she is "not the fairy-tale princess that everyone would like to see her"

And, despite these words, it is impossible to deny that her curtsies are the most elegant and perfect in the whole royal circle.
