

REPORTED SPEECH

КОСВЕННАЯ РЕЧЬ

Reported speech (statements)

- Mary says: “I enjoy reading”- Mary says (that) she enjoys reading
- Mary says: “My friend was in France last summer” – Mary says (that) her friend was in France the summer before
- Mary says: “I will become famous one day” –Mary says (that) she will become famous one day

Reported Speech

(orders, commands, recommendations)

- Mary says: “Be quiet, Bill” – Mary tells Bill to be quiet
- Mary warns her brother: “Don’t go there” – Mary warns her brother not to go there.

Reported speech (questions)

- Mary asks: “Kate, do you like reading?” – Mary asks Kate if she likes reading.
- Mary asks: “Kate, where did you spend your holidays” – Mary wonders where Kate spent her holidays

Reported speech (reporting verbs)

- Say (to smb) – говорить (сказать)
- Tell (smb) – говорить (рассказать)
- Ask (smb) – спрашивать/просить
- Order – приказывать
- Advise – советовать
- Warn – предупреждать
- Wonder - интересоваться

Reported speech

SAY-TELL

- Mary says: “Kate, you are my best friend”
Mary *says to* Kate that she is her best friend.
Mary *tells* Kate that she is her best friend

- My sister says to me: “Diana spent her holidays at the seaside.”
- Nick says: “I have never been to London.”
- “Put this letter into the envelope and give it to Kate”, she asks her friend
- “Please, bring me some water”, I ask my son.
- “Come here tomorrow”, she says to me.
- “Don’t stay there long”, I ask my daughter.
- “Don’t leave the room until I come back!”, I say to the children.
