

# **Rugby School** **Private boarding school for** **boys**







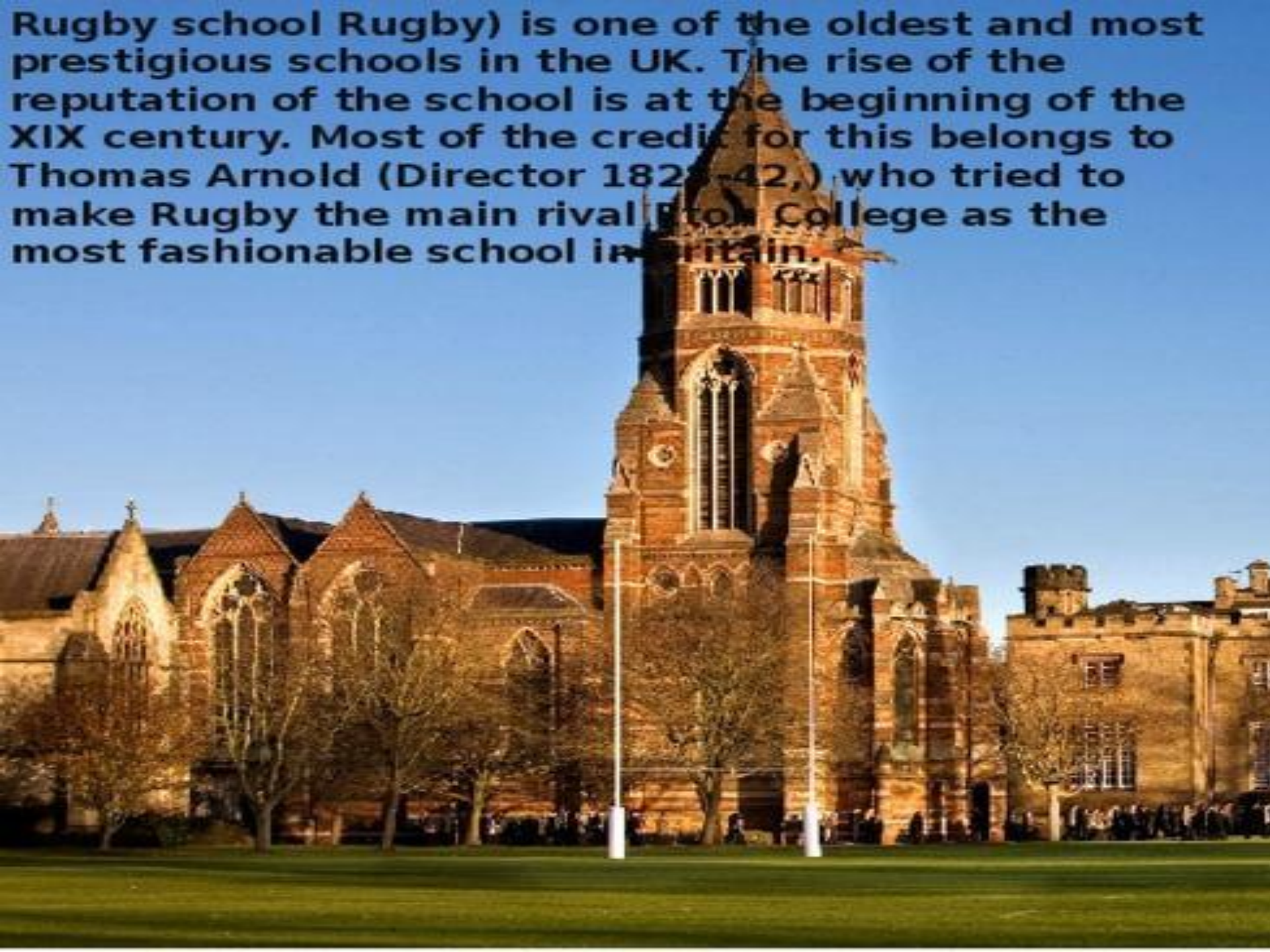

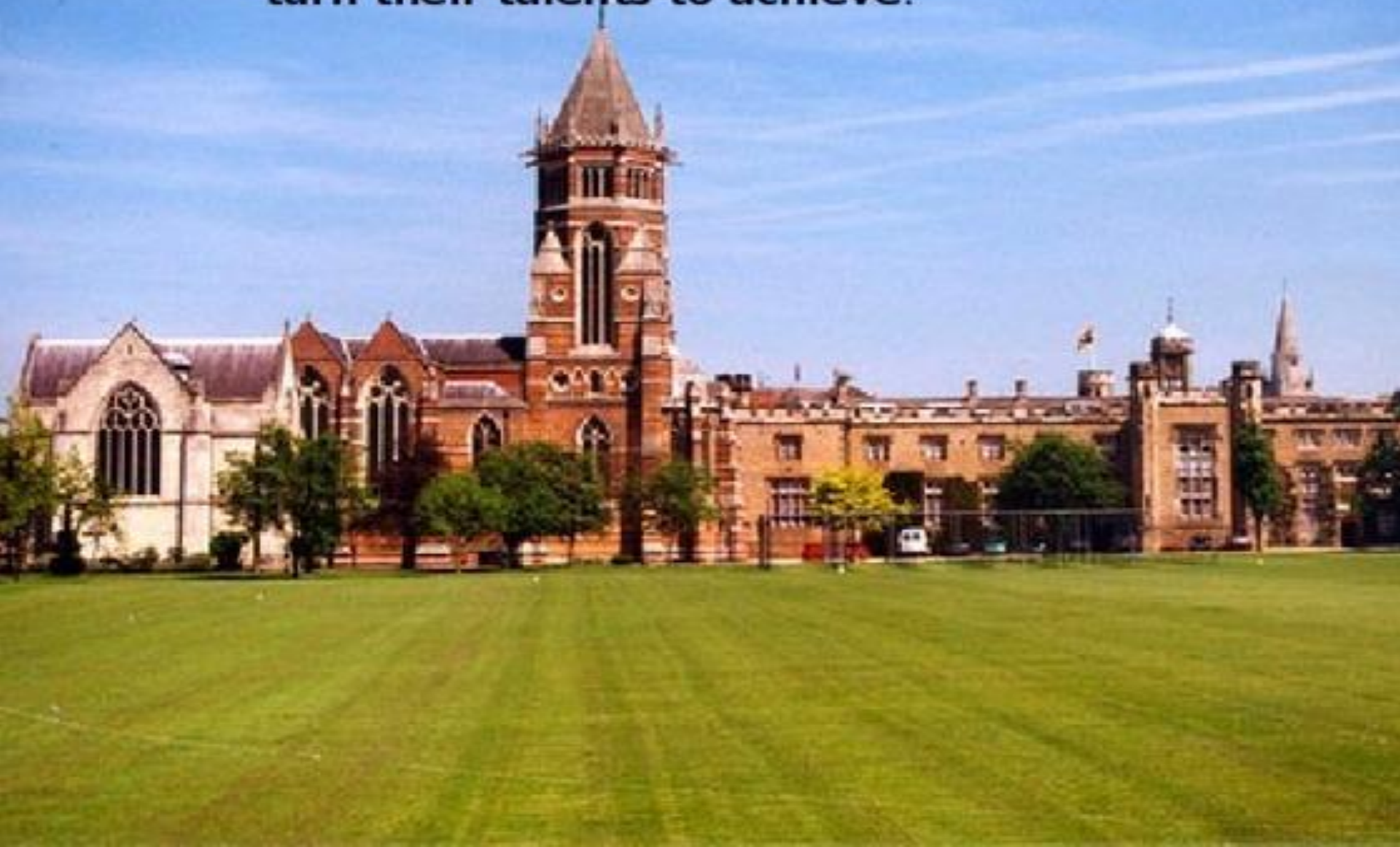


**Rugby School has its place in history as the place of the invention of the sport of Rugby. In 1823, a Local boy first ran with the ball and invented later became an incredibly popular game**



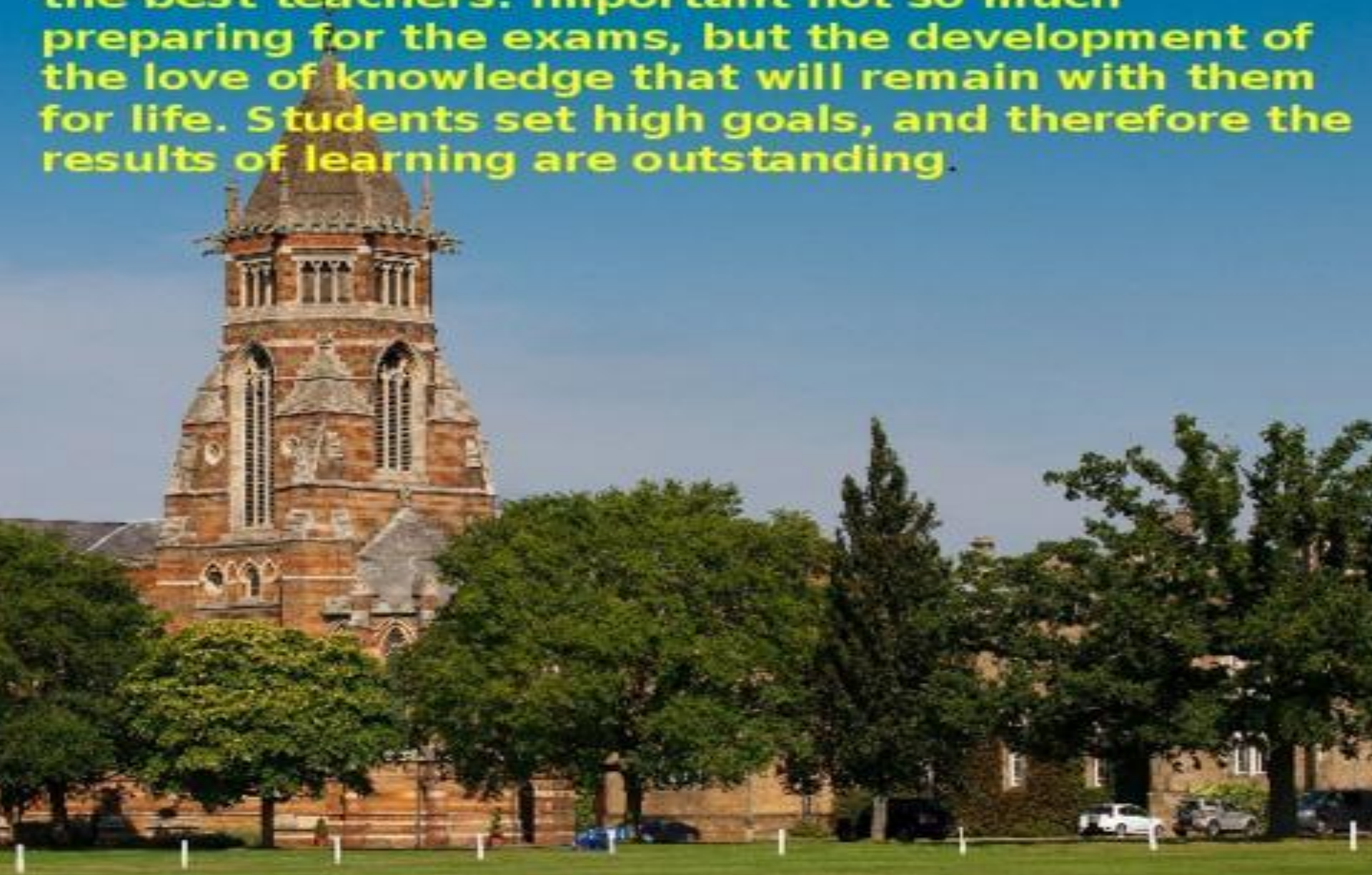


**Academic success is important, but not more than human values that surround him. Kids learn their "I", their strengths and weaknesses, learn how to turn their talents to achieve.**



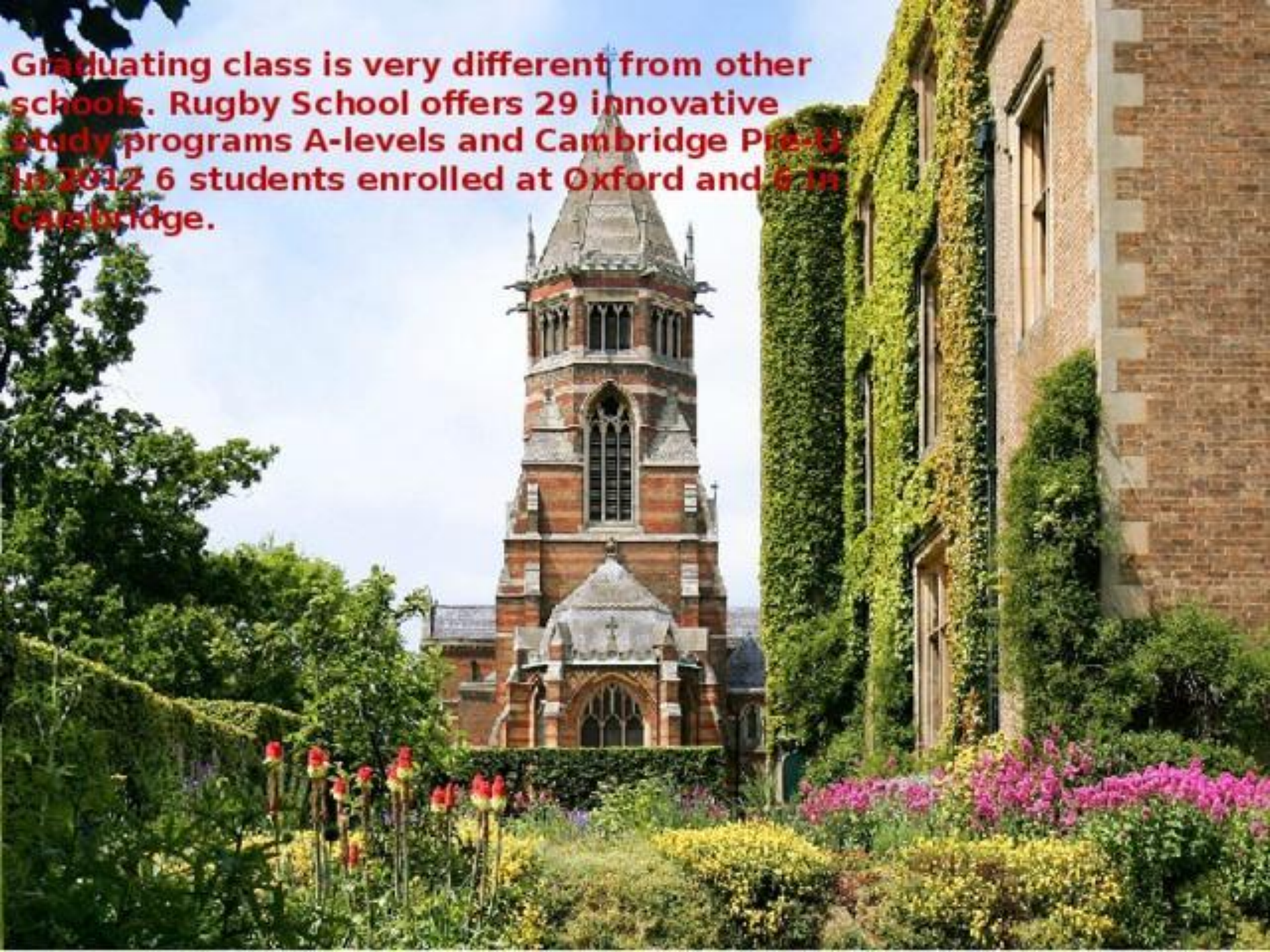
