
RELATIVE CLAUSES



What relative pronouns to use?

- I told you about the woman lives next door.
- Do you see the cat _____ is lying on the roof?
- He couldn't read _____ surprised me.
- Do you know the boy _____ mother is a nurse?
- I was invited by the professor _____ I met at the conference.
- This is the shop _____ I bought my bike.
- The reason _____ we met him is unknown.



<u>Defining relative clauses (no comma)</u>

- The writer who/that wrote The Grapes of Wrath is my favourite author.
- In the letters which/that she never opened everything was explained.
- The boy (who/whom/that) we met yesterday is very nice.



Non-Defining Relative Clauses (with comma); NO ,,that"!

- John Steinbeck, who wrote The Grapes of Wrath, is my favourite author.
- In the letters, which she never opened, everything was explained.
- Jim, who/whom we met yesterday, is very nice.



Relative pronouns — necessary or not? (We can leave object pronouns in defining clauses only)

- The book which I bought is not very good.
- The Thames is a river which runs through London.
- A guide is a person who shows tourists around a place.
- Cheese is food which mice like eating.

Common mistakes

- SOMETHING, ANYTHING, NOTHING....never use "what"!
- He said something <u>that / which</u> I liked.
- (NEVER USE: He said something what I like)
- The boy which did it will be punished.
- He did nothing what I liked.
- Where is the girl, who sells the tickets?
- The stone fell on my head was quite big.
- It is the song, that I like a lot.
- This is the only way how to learn English
