Lessons to be learnt from Singapore's experience

- 1. Political leaders have to be sincerely committed to elimination of corruption
- Use of complex anticorruption measures since separate laws and regulations are not sufficient



Lessons to be learnt from Singapore's experience

- 3. The independent anticorruption agency must itself be incorruptible
- 4. Anticorruption agency should process independently from police



Lessons to be learnt from Singapore's experience

- 5. Periodical review of those departments which are most vulnerable to corrupt activities
- 6. The issue of low salary of civil servants must be addressed with increase in long-run
