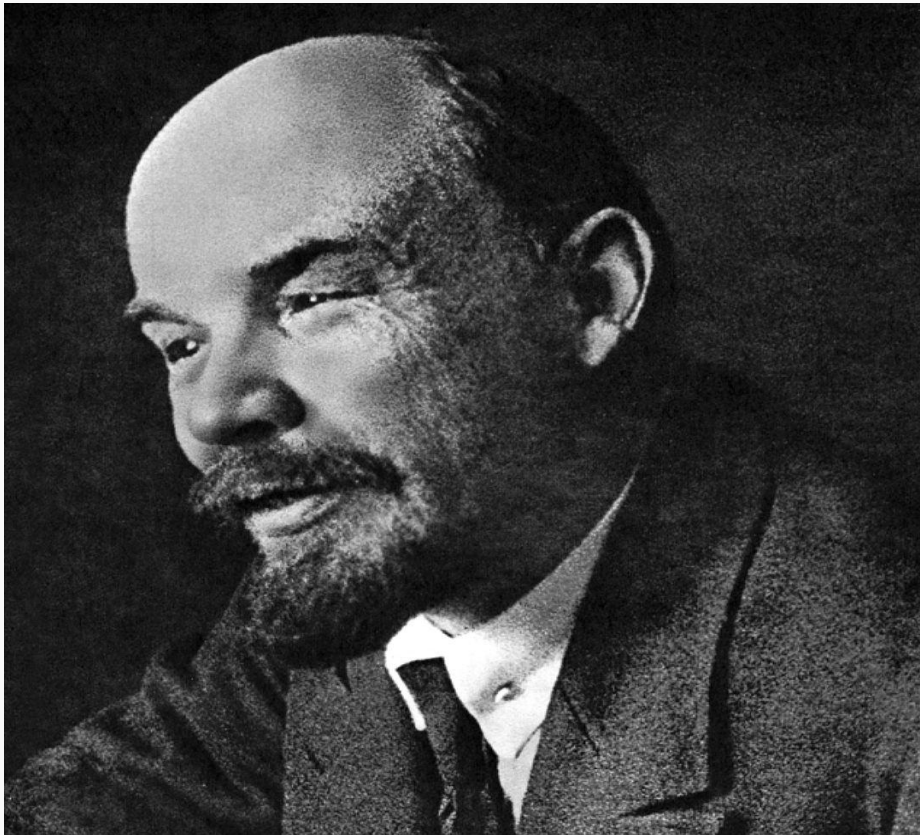


Vladimir Ilyich Lenin

Marxist writer, founder of Marxism-Leninism, the ideologist and founder of the Third (Communist) international, the founder of the Soviet Union,



The scope of the main political and journalistic works - materialist philosophy, the theory of Marxism, criticism of capitalism and imperialism, the theory and practice of socialist revolution and construction of socialism and communism, the political economy of socialism.

Forming and development of aesthetic looks of Lenin was assisted his richest erudition, thorough knowledge and study of the phenomena of home and world culture, revolutionary-democratic aesthetics, and also his unchanging interest in the different types of art, especially to literature and music, and sound acquaintance with them, direct intermingling with visible cultural and art workers



In Russia more than 7 thousand monuments to Lenin

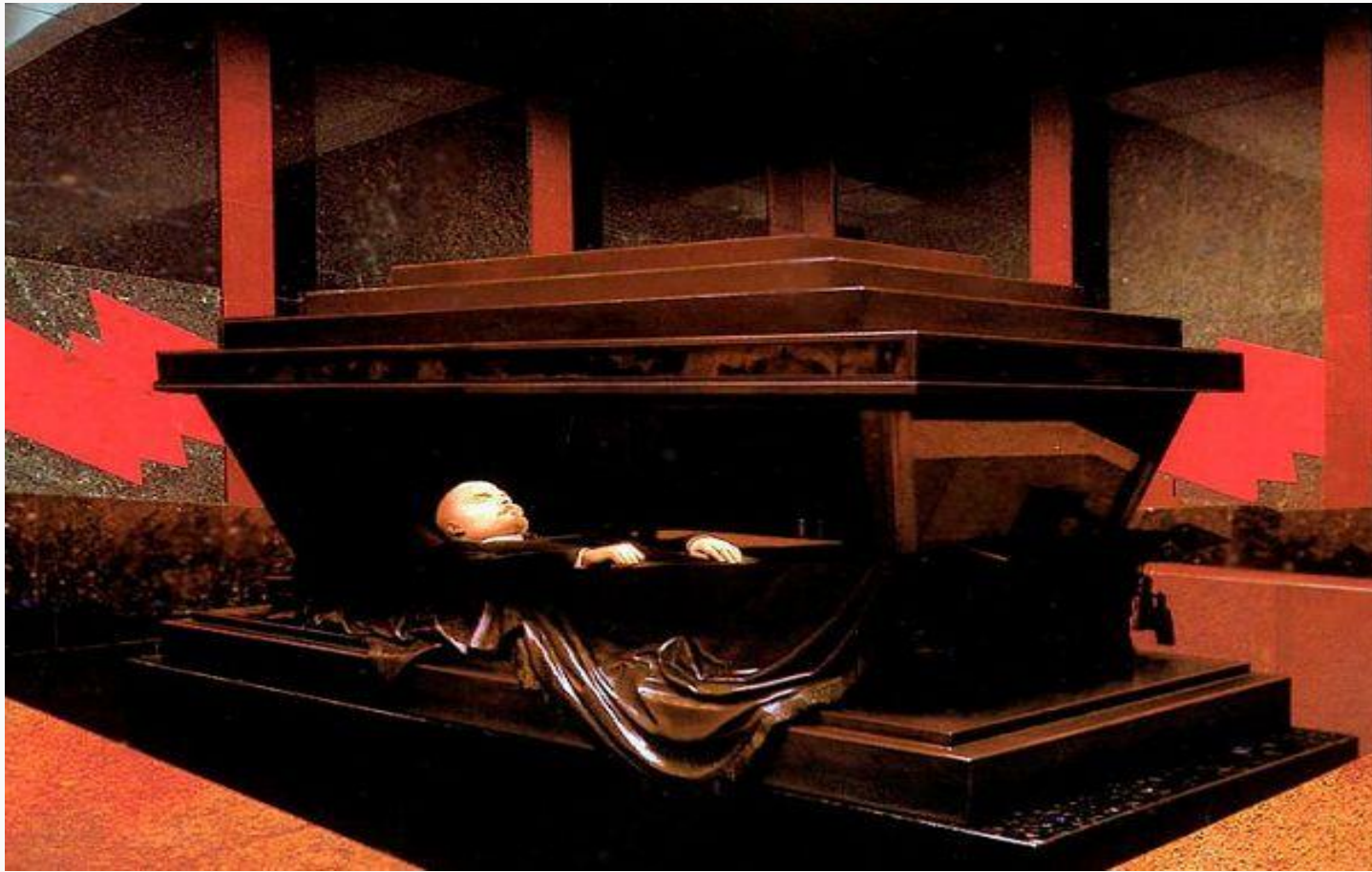
In Saint Petersburg, taking into account suburbs, more than 150 monuments were set to Lenin

in Moscow - more than 200. Saved, about 70 and hardly more than 100.

In May, 1922 Lenin became ill heavily, but on October 2 went back to work. Probably, illness of Vladimir Ilich was caused by a strong overload and consequences of attempt of August 30, 1918.

Lenin buried in Moscow on the Red area, in Mausoleum.
