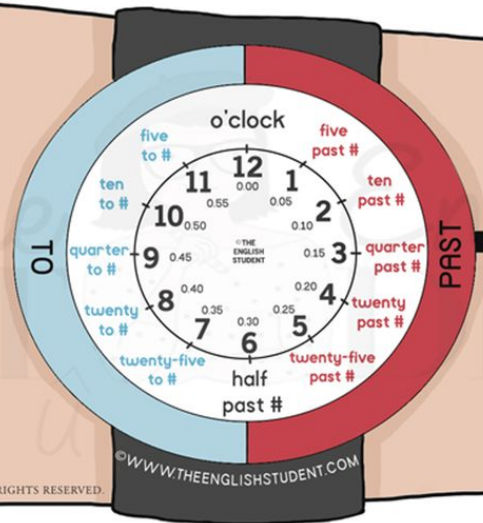

12:20 = TWENTY PAST TWELVE / TWELVE TWENTY

12:30 = HALF PAST TWELVE / TWELVE THIRTY

12:50 = TEN TO ONE / TWELVE FIFTY

Comparatives: Short adjectives

Short adjectives ...	Spelling rules	Examples
Usually	+ er	slow → slower fast → faster tall → taller
Ending in -e	+ r	large → larger nice → nicer
Some two-syllable adjectives, especially ending in -y	-y → -i + er	hungry → hungrier happy → happier funny → funnier
Ending in a vowel + a consonant	double the consonant + er	big → bigger fat → fatter fit → fitter

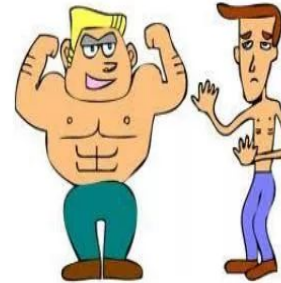
COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVES

When comparing 2 things.

- *One syllable adjectives*: add -er

Cold → colder

High → higher



- *One syllable adjectives ending in one vowel + consonant*:
double the consonant and add -er

Big → bigger

Hot → hotter

NOUN 1 + verb + COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVE + THAN + NOUN 2

Southern states are colder than northern states.

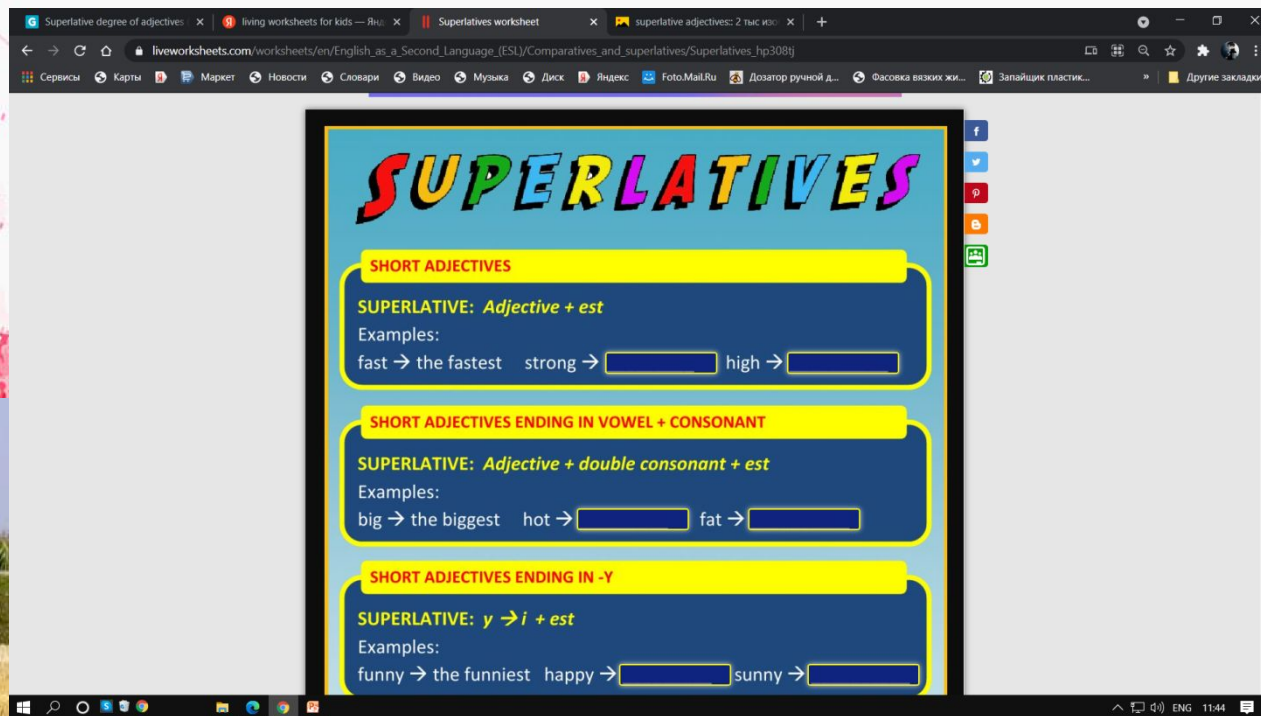


Short adjectives: Comparatives and superlatives

Positive	Comparative	Superlative
adjective	adjective + -er	(the)adjective+ -est
long	longer	the longest
tall	taller	the tallest
small	smaller	the smallest

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SUPERLATIVES

SHORT ADJECTIVES

SUPERLATIVE: Adjective + est

Examples:
fast → the fastest strong → high →

SHORT ADJECTIVES ENDING IN VOWEL + CONSONANT

SUPERLATIVE: Adjective + double consonant + est

Examples:
big → the biggest hot → fat →

SHORT ADJECTIVES ENDING IN -Y

SUPERLATIVE: y → i + est

Examples:
funny → the funniest happy → sunny →

COMPARATIVE AND SUPERLATIVE RULE 1

ADJECTIVE	COMPARATIVE (-er)	SUPERLATIVE (-est)
Big	Bigger	The biggest
Hot	Hotter	The hottest
Wet	Wetter	The wettest
Sad	Sadder	The saddest
Thin	Thinner	The thinnest



Positive	Comparative	Superlative
4. simple	simpl er / more simple	the simpl est / the most simple
cruel		
friendly, clever, common, gentle, polite, handsome, narrow, pleasant, quiet		
5. good	better	the best
bad	worse	the worst
many/ much	more	the most
little	less	the least
far	farther/ further	the farthest/ furthest
old	older/ elder	the oldest/ eldest



COMPARATIVE AND SUPERLATIVE RULE 4

ADJECTIVE	COMPARATIVE (more)	SUPERLATIVE (most)
Comfortable	More comfortable	The most comfortable
Interesting	More interesting	The most interesting
Expensive	More expensive	The most expensive
Beautiful	More beautiful	The most beautiful
Difficult	More difficult	The most difficult
