Система оценивания ответов экзаменуемых на задания экзаменационной работы по иностранным языкам

- **Раздел 4 «Письмо» проверяется и оценивается экспертной комиссией в соответствии со специально разработанными критериями оценивания письменных работ:**

K1 - содержание,

K2 - организация текста,

K3 - лексика,

K4 - грамматика,

K5 - орфография и пунктуация.

Первое задание (**письмо личного характера**) оценивается по первым двум критериям (**K1 и K2**) – **max 6**

Второе задание (**письменное высказывание**) оценивается по 5 критериям, представленным в шкале оценивания.

На основе критериев, эксперт может выставить от **0 до 3** баллов по первым четырем критериям и от **0 до 2-х** баллов за 5-й – **max 14**

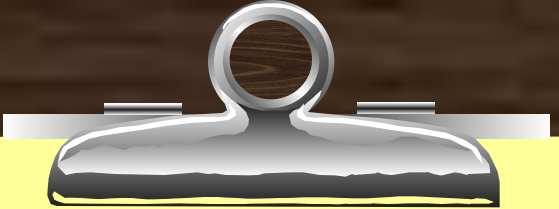

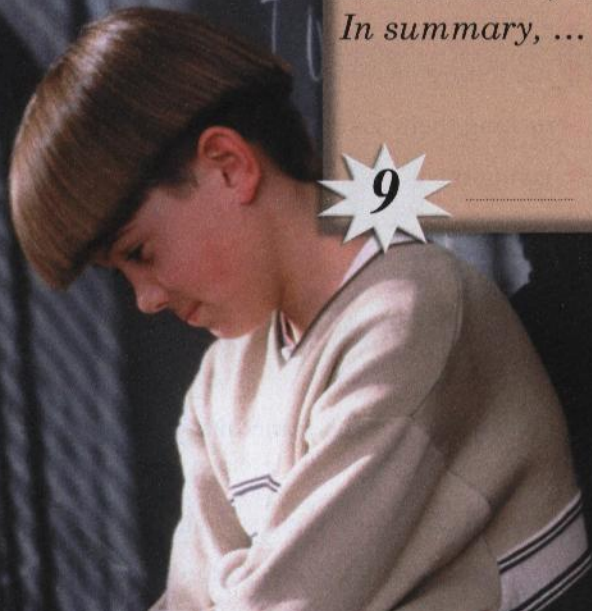
